



SEW ON YOUR OWN SNAPS

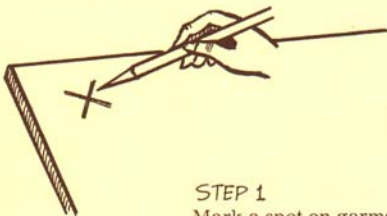

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There are two parts to a snap. One part has a ball in the middle of it.

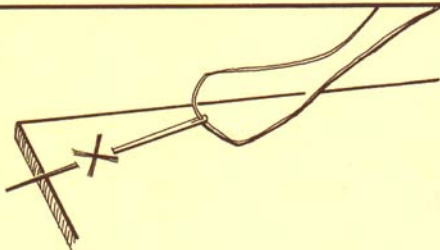


The other part has a hole in the middle of it.



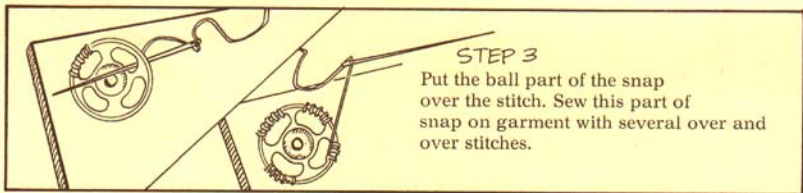
STEP 1

Mark a spot on garment with pencil where snap is to be sewn.



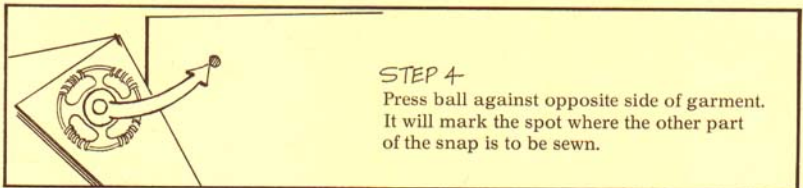
STEP 2

Take a stitch in the garment.



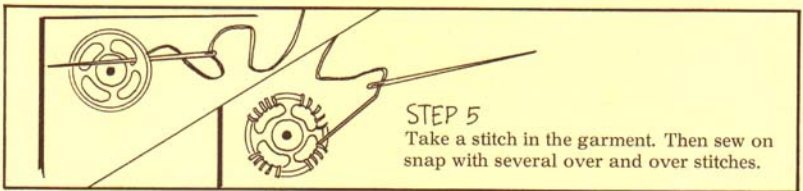
STEP 3

Put the ball part of the snap over the stitch. Sew this part of snap on garment with several over and over stitches.



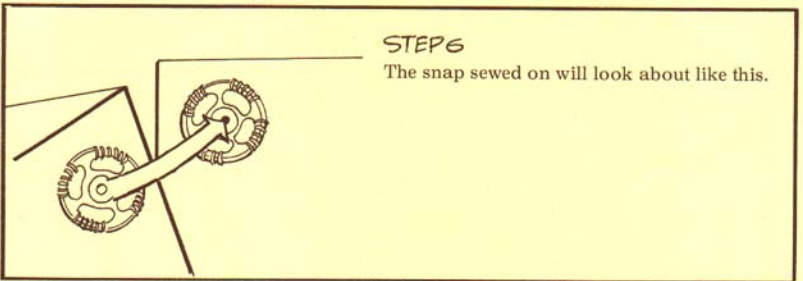
STEP 4

Press ball against opposite side of garment. It will mark the spot where the other part of the snap is to be sewn.



STEP 5

Take a stitch in the garment. Then sew on snap with several over and over stitches.



STEP 6

The snap sewed on will look about like this.
