## THEACEOFTRUM

-Capt. Georges Guynemer of the French aviation corps, the outstanding hero of the air battles of the war, and national idol, next to Joffre, of France. To the right is the famous aviator, with his father, mother, and sister, on the steps of their home at Compiegne. Below (to the right) is Guynemer with the charred remains of two machine guns from the ruins of his thirty-seventh German air victim, and (to the left) he is in conversation with Gen. Lyautey, the French minister of war, who resigned in March. He was promoted to captaincy at the age of 21 after he had brought down five German aeroplanes within five months.
