ments, the men engaged in the business here have interests in timber lands, sawmills, logging railroads and other adjuncts of the business, the financial data of which it would be a herculean task to collect. Chicago capital in the lumber business is invested from the Atlantic to the Pacific, as well as in Mexico, Cuba and Canada. Numerous offices of lumbermen are scattered through the business district in which a wholesale business of indeterminate quantity is transacted, not only in Chicago but throughout the country; for not all the lumber, by a large quantity, handled by Chicago dealers comes to this city, but is shipped from point to point hundreds—even thousands—of miles from here. Men of no business as a class take a wider sweep in their operations than Chicago lumbermen. Their capital within recent years has been invested in timber lands and sawmills plants to a vast extent in all the yellow pine and hardwood states of the south, in Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico and Old Mexico. Several of the old, powerful white pine interests of the city have acquired immense areas of pine land in the Gulf states and have transferred their main manufacturing branches to that section. The sons and former employees of the old northern pine producers have taken up the work where the elder men retired from it, and are expanding timber holdings and lumber manufacture to a degree that promises to exceed anything that their predecessors accomplished.

One of the foremost industries of Chicago is the hardwood lumber business. This city stands preeminently in the world as a consumer of hardwood lumber. Beyond this its capital is invested in hardwood timber and the manufacture of lumber in Michigan, Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee, Missouri, Arkansas, Texas, Louisiana, Georgia, Alabama and South Carolina.

The foundation of the immense consuming demand for hardwood lumber in Chicago is the numberless factories employed in making furniture, interior

finish, flooring, pianos, organs, coffins, bar fixtures, billiard tables and a great variety of other articles whose chief component is wood. In addition to this, many million feet of hardwood are annually employed as crating and boxing material, for the protection of goods being shipped.

The total receipts of lumber of all kinds during 1906 were 2,355,589,000 feet. Of this immense quantity only a little more than a billion feet was reshipped out of Chicago, the remainder of more than a billion and a quarter feet representing local consumption. It is safe to assume that the local consumption of hardwoods alone was approximately 450,000,000 feet. This quantity of hardwood lumber doubtless is nearly double that consumed by any other trade center of the United States during a single year. Another feature of the hardwood trade of Chicago lies in the fact that the consumption of hardwoods is gradually increasing while the consumption of soft or building woods shows a slight diminution.

The hardwood business of Chicago is handled by approximately a hundred concerns. These houses almost without exception stand high commercially, and very few of them confine their operations to local trade. The Chicago manufacturer and merchant sell their products from the Atlantic to the Pacific. The volume of trade indicated in the foregoing figures but ill represents the total business transacted by Chicago hardwood lumbermen, as a large portion of their shipments does not come to Chicago at all, but is moved direct from the sawmills to other points of consumption in various parts of the country. About fifty hardwood concerns of Chicago carry stocks of varying size in pile locally, while with others the business is transacted through general offices, almost invariably located in the "loop" district.

In the manufacture and marketing of hardwoods Chicago is extremely catholic. Every domestic and nearly every foreign wood is handled here in wholesale quantities. The greatest consumption is of white oak, red oak, maple, white ash, black
