Spring Revue

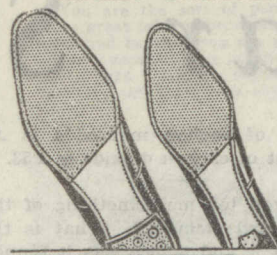
