COUNT MORDERING



OU can't help but save money by buying your groceries direct, at wholesale prices, the Wilson Way. Even if you buy only in small quantities, you will make a substantial saving. But if you learn the little things that count in buying by mail, you can make even larger savings.

While express or parcels post shipment will undoubtedly be entirely satisfactory for those desiring to order a few lightweight articles, such as cigars, toilet accessories, etc., or for use in ordering groceries where exceptionally quick delivery is desired, we cannot emphasize too strongly the advisability of ordering all groceries "shipped by freight" in lots of 100 pounds or more.

Under government freight regulations the minimum freight charge is fifty cents, no matter how small the shipment. For instance, if your order weighs thirty pounds, when packed, and your neighbor's order weighs one hundred pounds, his freight on the one hundred-pound shipment will cost no more than your freight on the thirty-pound shipment, provided the freight rate from Peoria to your station does not exceed fifty cents. Again, if the fourth class freight rate from Peoria to

your shipping point is twenty-five cents or less, your freight charge on two hundred pounds of fourth class freight will amount to only the minimum charge of fifty cents.

This means that the minimum charge will cover a shipment of two hundred pounds of fourth class freight from Peoria to any point in Illinois, or a shipment of one hundred pounds of fourth class freight from Peoria to any point in Iowa, Indiana, Michigan or Wisconsin, and to nearly any point in Missouri, Minnesota, Kentucky or Ohio

The freight charge on shipments containing first, second and third class freight will be proportionately higher, but the relative charges on large and small shipments

will be proportionately higher, but the relative charges on large and small shipments will be the same.

When you are ready to place your next order, take stock carefully. Estimate how much of each item constitutes a month's supply for you. You will find that in some cases you will require a dozen or a case of some items instead of the three or six you had thought to order.

If after you have estimated your necessary supplies your order is still less than you want to have shipped, get some of your friends to combine with you in making up a big order. In this way you can take advantage of the additional saving offered by the lower quantity prices. If you do this, however, be sure to give your order under one name to be shipped to one address.

All transportation charges are to be paid by the customer, and remember, the freight on one hundred pounds is no more than on thirty pounds.
