

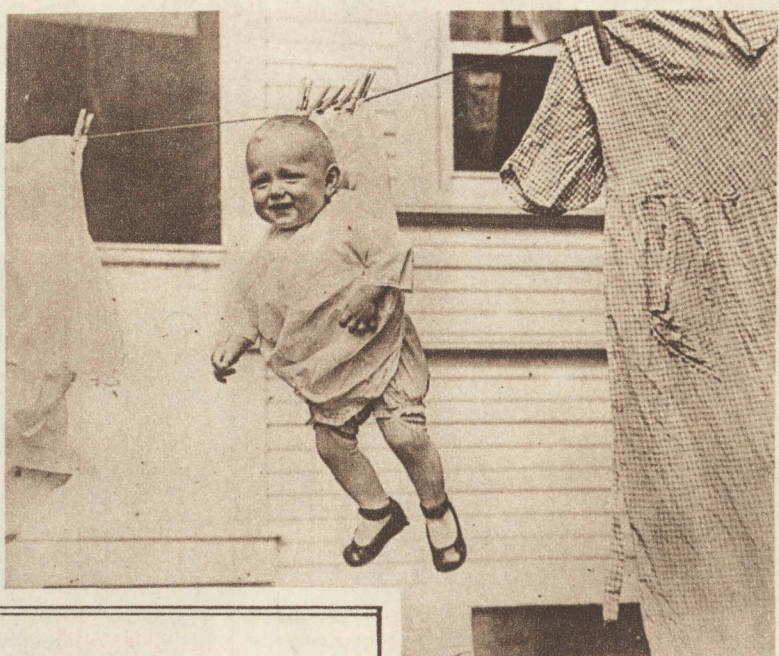

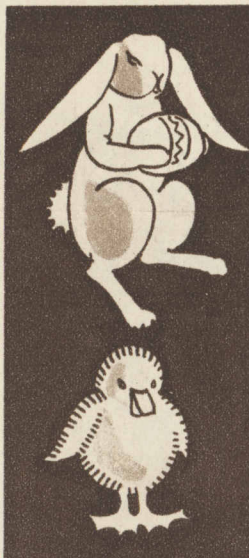
DOWN FOR A COUNT OF NINE—An unusual spill,

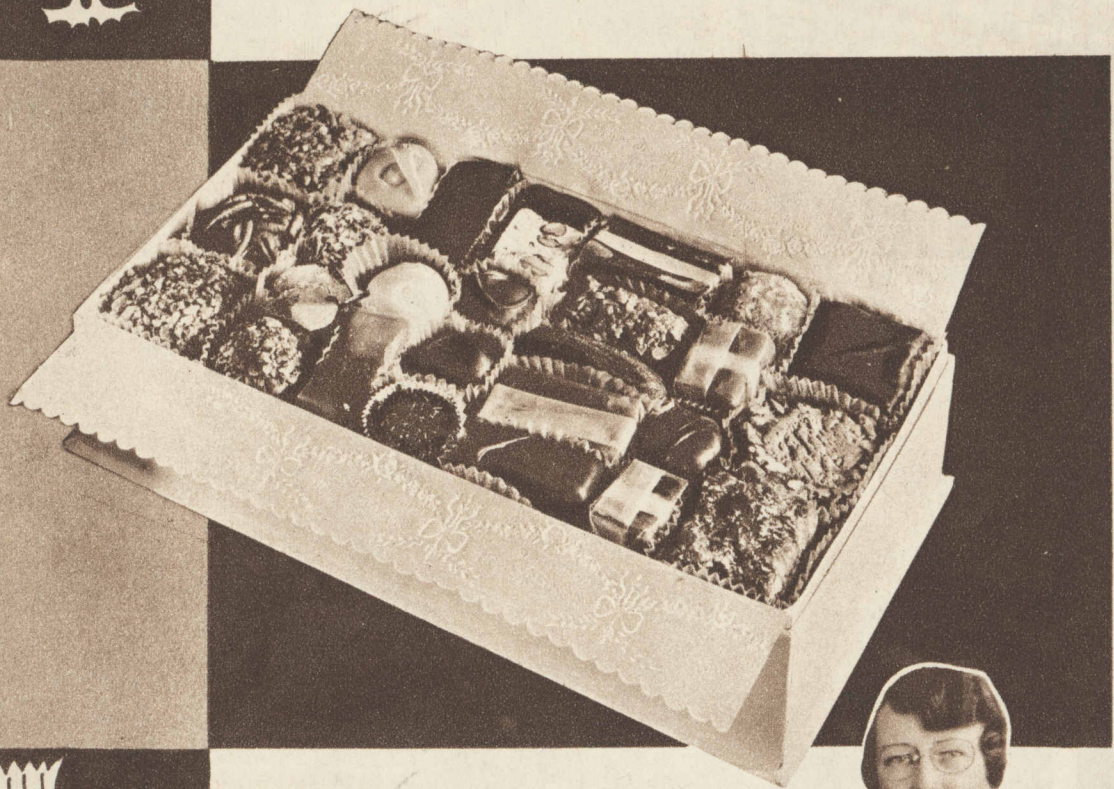
THE \$250,000,000 ROCKEFELLER "RADIO CITY," which is to rise in the heart of
