# FREE CITY CLINIC **GIVING NEW HOPE** TO TUBERCULARS

Real Progress Shown in 6 Months' Operation.

The new public tuberculosis clinic, opened six months ago in the old Iroquois Memorial hospital, 23 North Wacker drive, which at that time was called a new hope for thousands, is justifying the prediction, according to Dr. Allan J. Hruby, secretary of the board of directors of the Municipal Tuberculosis sanitarium, which conducts the clinic. Starting with 75 pa-1,973 since Oct. 17 and all have shown marked progress, said Dr. Hruby.

About 110 a day are ministered to now. The clinic is believed to be the only one in the world devoted exclusively to treatment by the lung collapse the lung. The pressure causes collapse, which insures vital rest for the entente. diseased organ

Positive Progress Shown.

'The clinic was opened so that the tubercular patients in Chicago whose disease was advancing, sometimes even to death, while they waited to get into the municipal sanitarium and other charitable institutions, would have a break. There is now no excuse for a single tuberculosis patient in Chicago not having treatment."

No Waiting List at Clinic. There is no waiting list at the clinic and will not be, according to Dr. E. P. Troy, superintendent of the dispensary for the sanitarium. The clinic is now open Tuesday and Fri-

day nights. The record of one patient was obtained. It was that of a man who on Oct. 14 suffered from an advanced case of pulmonary tuberculosis. His temperature was 101 degrees. He had a severe cough and weighed 132

Now his temperature is normal, he weighs 165 pounds, he has been germ free since Jan. 17, and his cough has






