ESTIMATE MAY 1 MOVING DAY WILL BREAK RECORDS

About 40,000 Chicago families will move during the May 1 moving period-probably the largest number since 1930-according to an estimate made yesterday by Fred M. Lorish, president of the Chicago Real Estate board. His estimate is based on requests to service companies for changes in addresses of installations. The Peoples Gas Light and Coke company reports that these have been more numerous than at any other time in the last 15 years.

Mr. Lorish said part of the increase in moving is due to higher rents. Dan Healy, secretary of the Movers' Association of Chicago, and William O'Brien, secretary of the Van Movers union, reported moving companies had been swamped with orders, which Healy said were heavier than in any other of the 13 years he has been with the association.
