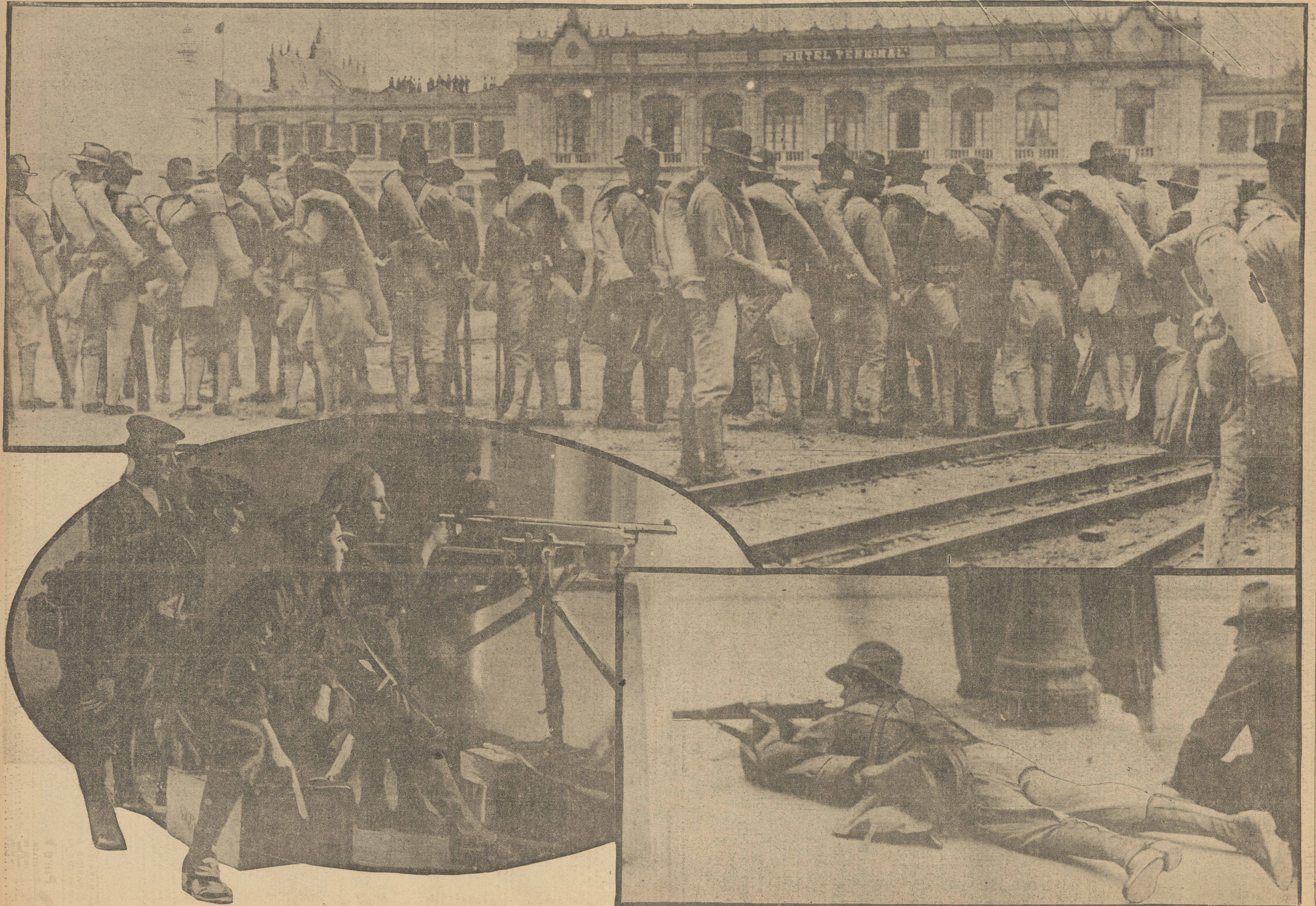


# Marines in Front of Vera Cruz Hotel; Machine Gun at Work; Picking off Enemy.
