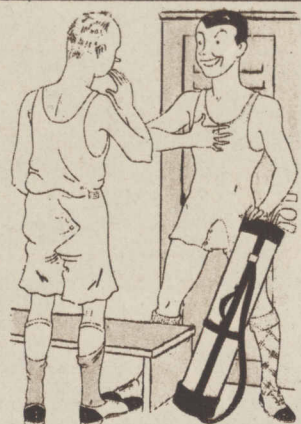

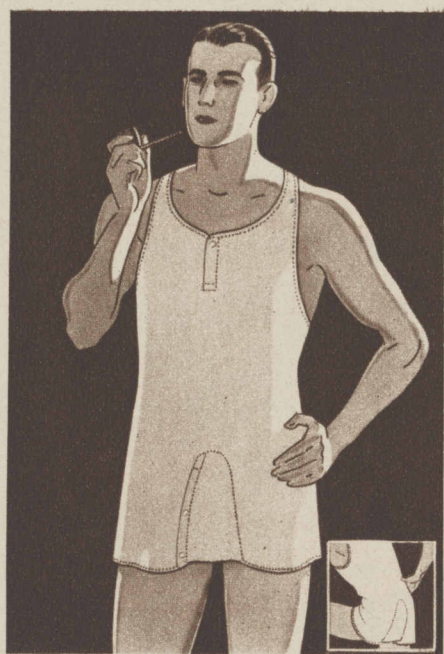
ACROSS THIS LITTLE LAKE looms the pass which leads over Victoria glacier to Lake Louise.

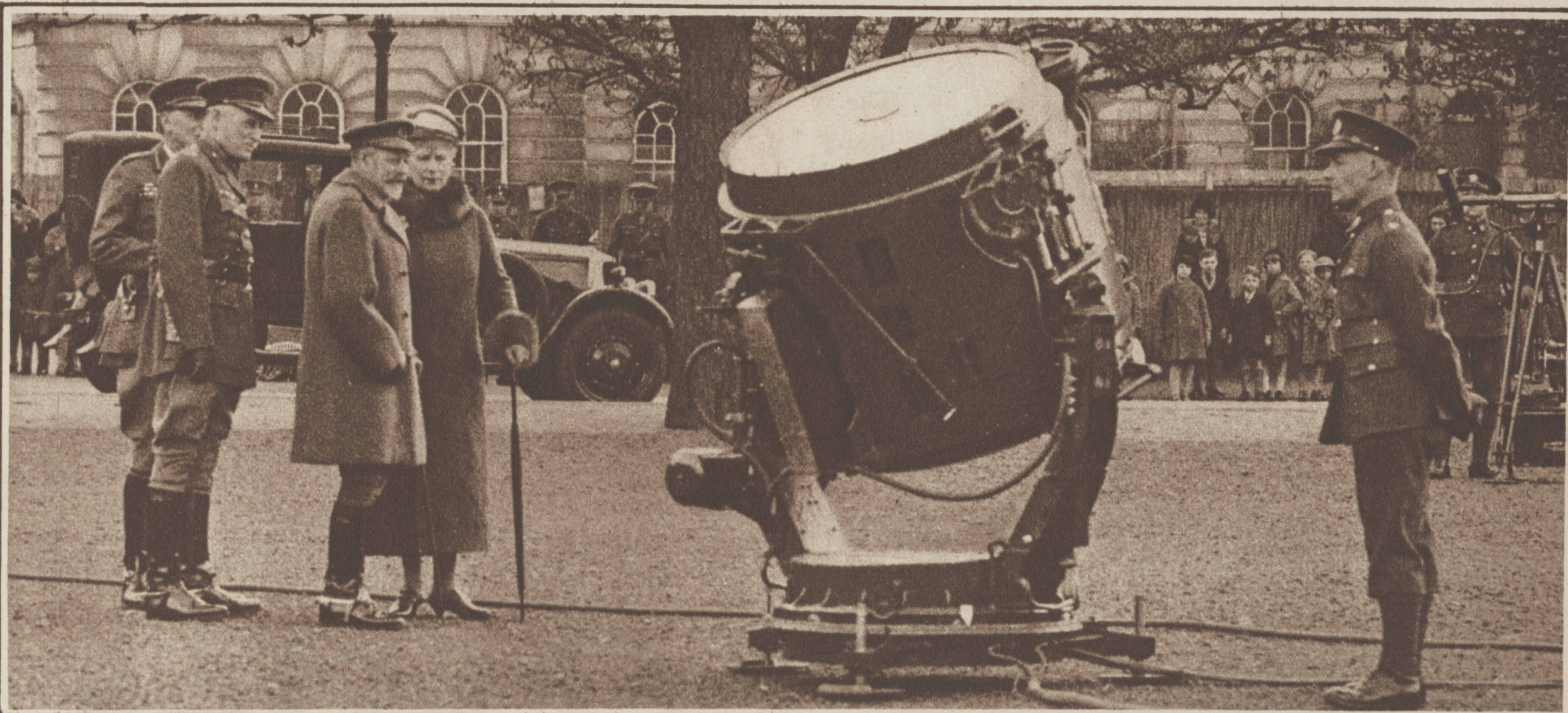
