

PLAYGROUNDS OF THE PEOPLE: A LORDLY PARK SYSTEM FOR ILLINOIS



STATE PARKS EXISTING AND PROPOSED are graphically indicated by this scenic map, prepared and copyrighted by the Friends of Our Native Landscape. Present parks, which embrace 2,800 acres, are indicated on the map by asterisks. Under the plan submitted by the board of park advisers to Gov. Emmerson, these parks would be a nucleus for a vast system of approximately 150,000 acres. Each tract circled on the map would contain at least a thousand acres, this being considered the minimum area necessary to preserve the state's outstanding scenic and historic landscapes. Principal state highways, by which motorists may visit the park areas, are indicated by the circled numbers.
