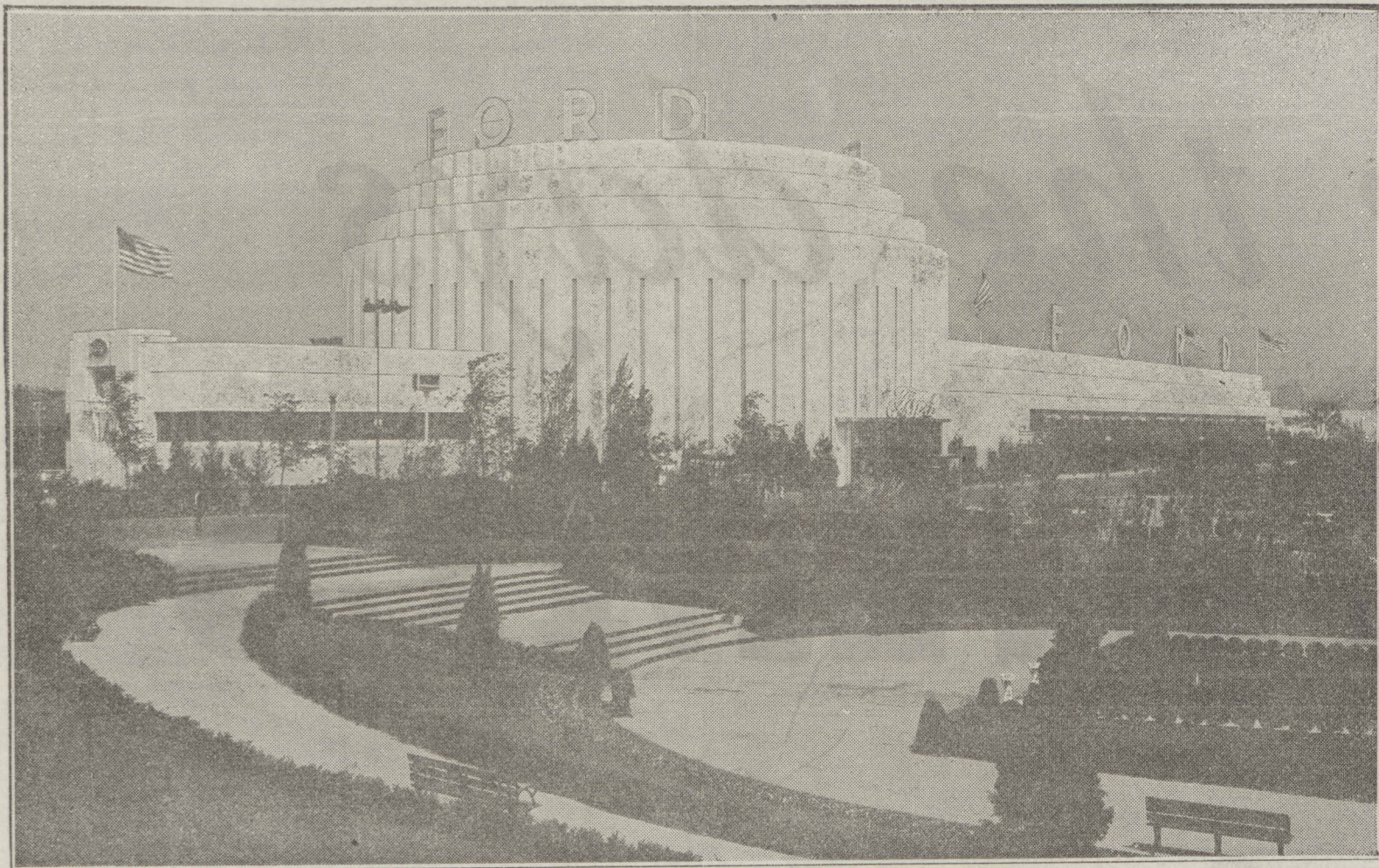
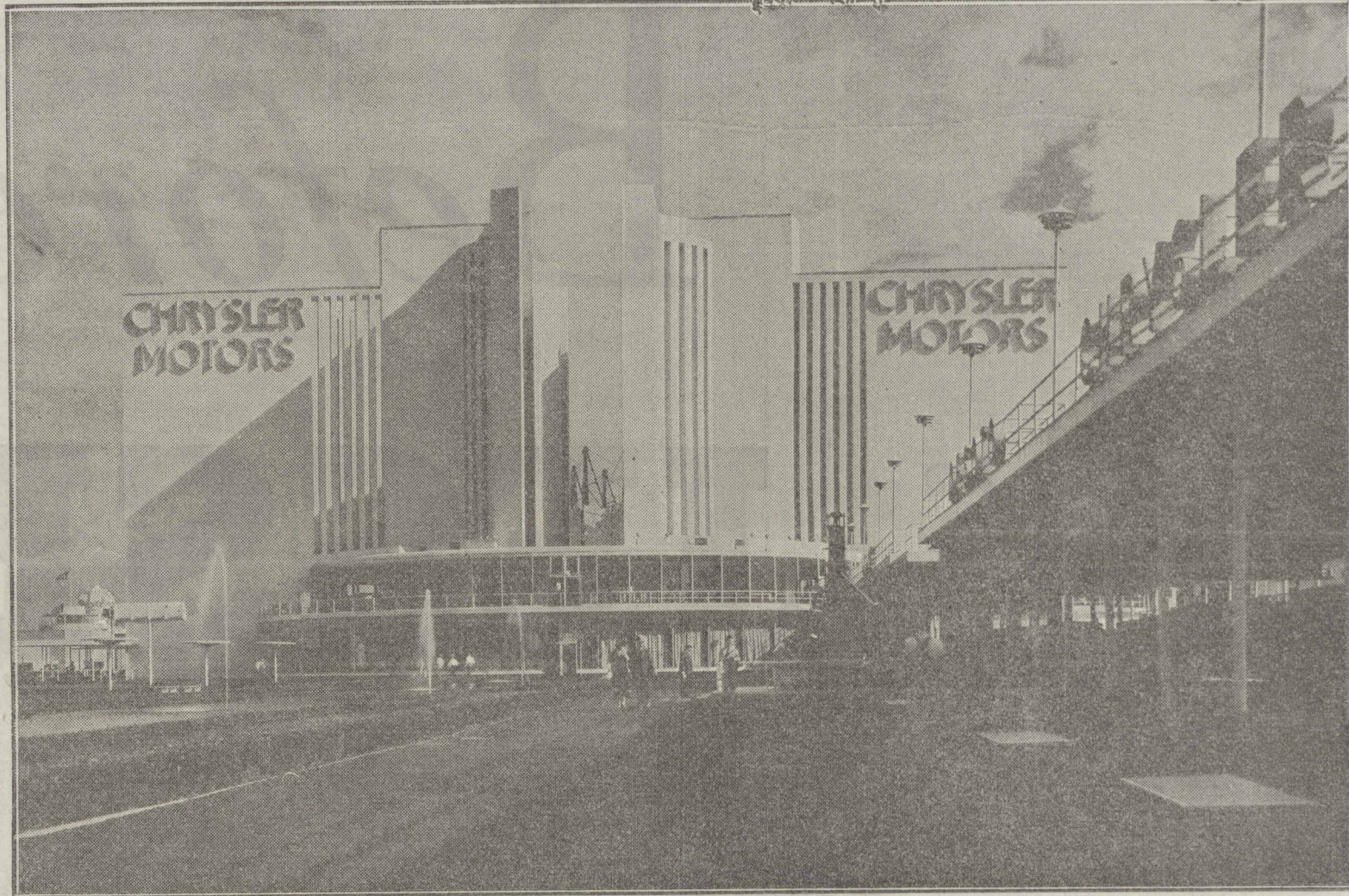


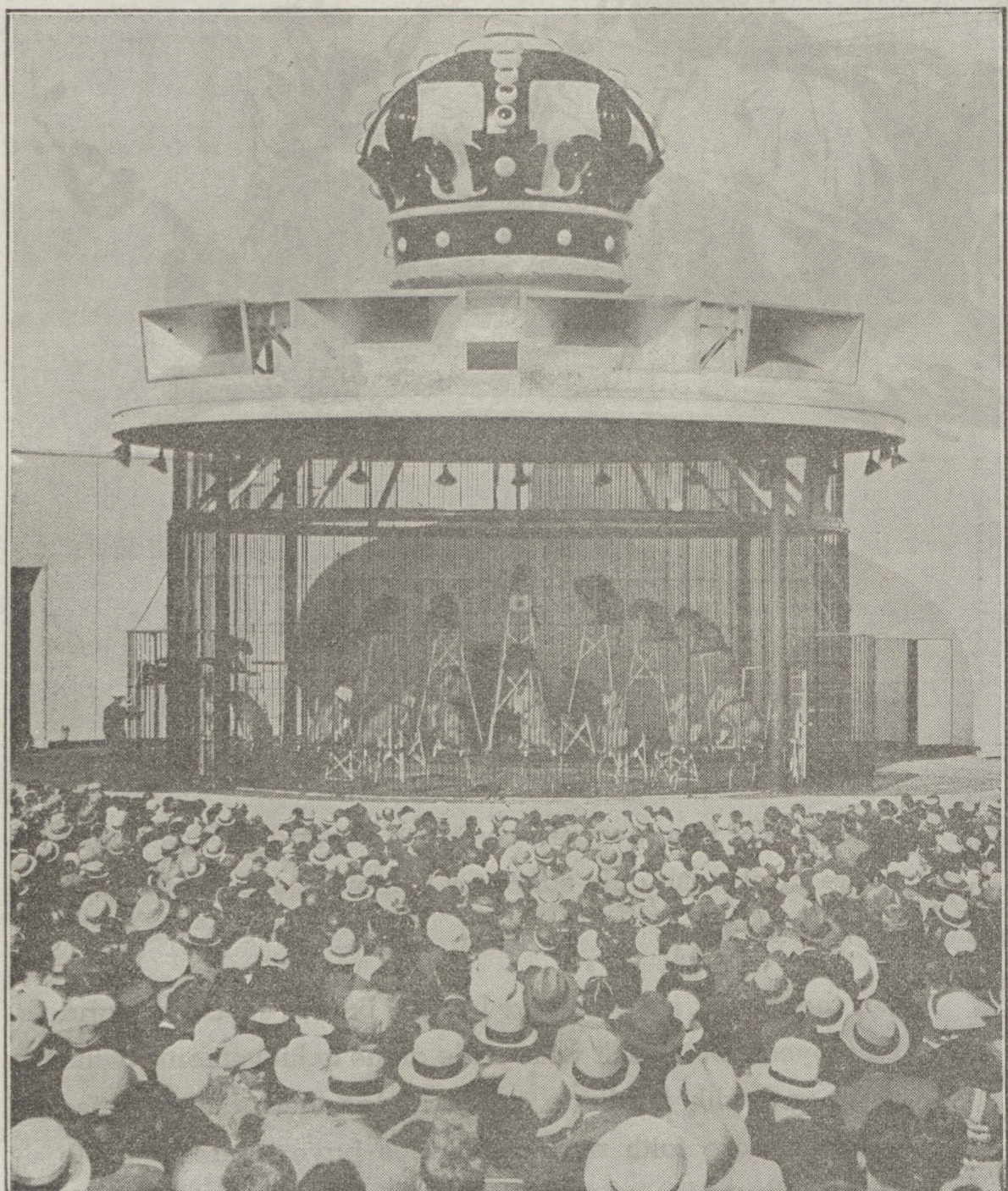
March of Progress of Automotive Industry Shown at Exposition—Wild Animals Entertain

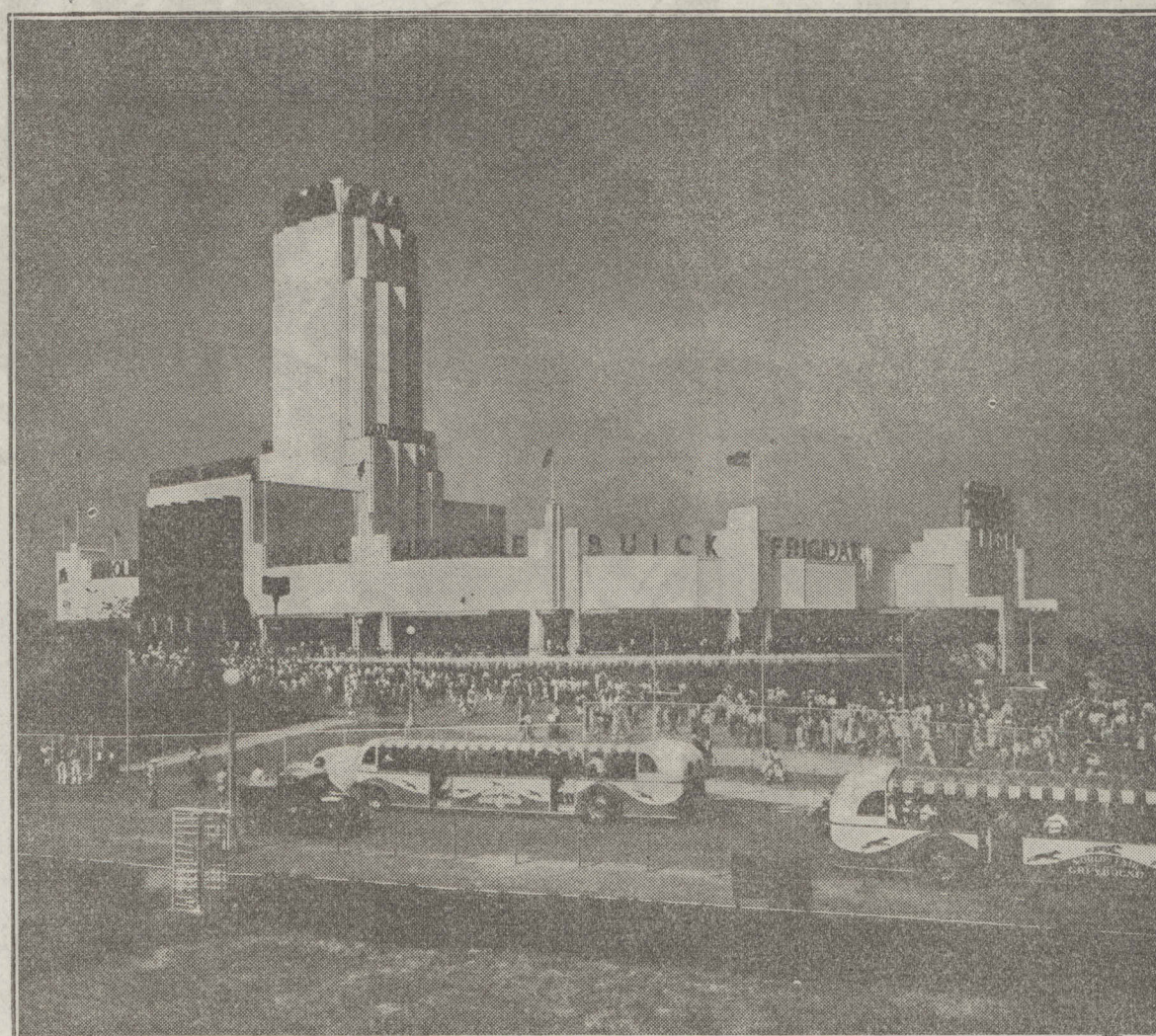
