
WHERE EUROPE MAY BE INVADED FROM ENGLAND



This is a new war map showing where the united nations, principally the United States and Great Britain, might hurl an invading army from England into France or the Low Countries in the event of an attempt to establish a second front against Germany to relieve the Nazi pressure on Russia. The north shoreline of Europe, from Denmark to Spain, guarded at many points by guns seized by the Germans when they took the Maginot line, presents hundreds of miles of open coast and bays, where boat borne troops, protected by swarms of planes, might effect landings. How many American troops are in the British Isles is a secret. The British themselves are said to have about three and a half million men under arms on the isles. Lines of advancement by land of an allied invading army, as shown by arrows on the map, follow the river valleys.
