



**SPOILS OF WAR**—The coloring and shadings in this map show at a glance the territory that has changed hands since the Great war. Black borders show present boundary lines. Territory that has been transferred is shown by laying the color of its former owner over the coloring of the present holder. Russia's tremendous losses are indicated by varying shades of the Russian purple. The bright yellow of old France becomes bright orange to indicate land France has acquired since the war. The old Roumania is indicated in brown; the purple, old rose, pink, and orange tan laid over brown within the present Roumanian borders indicate land taken, respectively, from Russia, Hungary, Bulgaria, and Austria.
