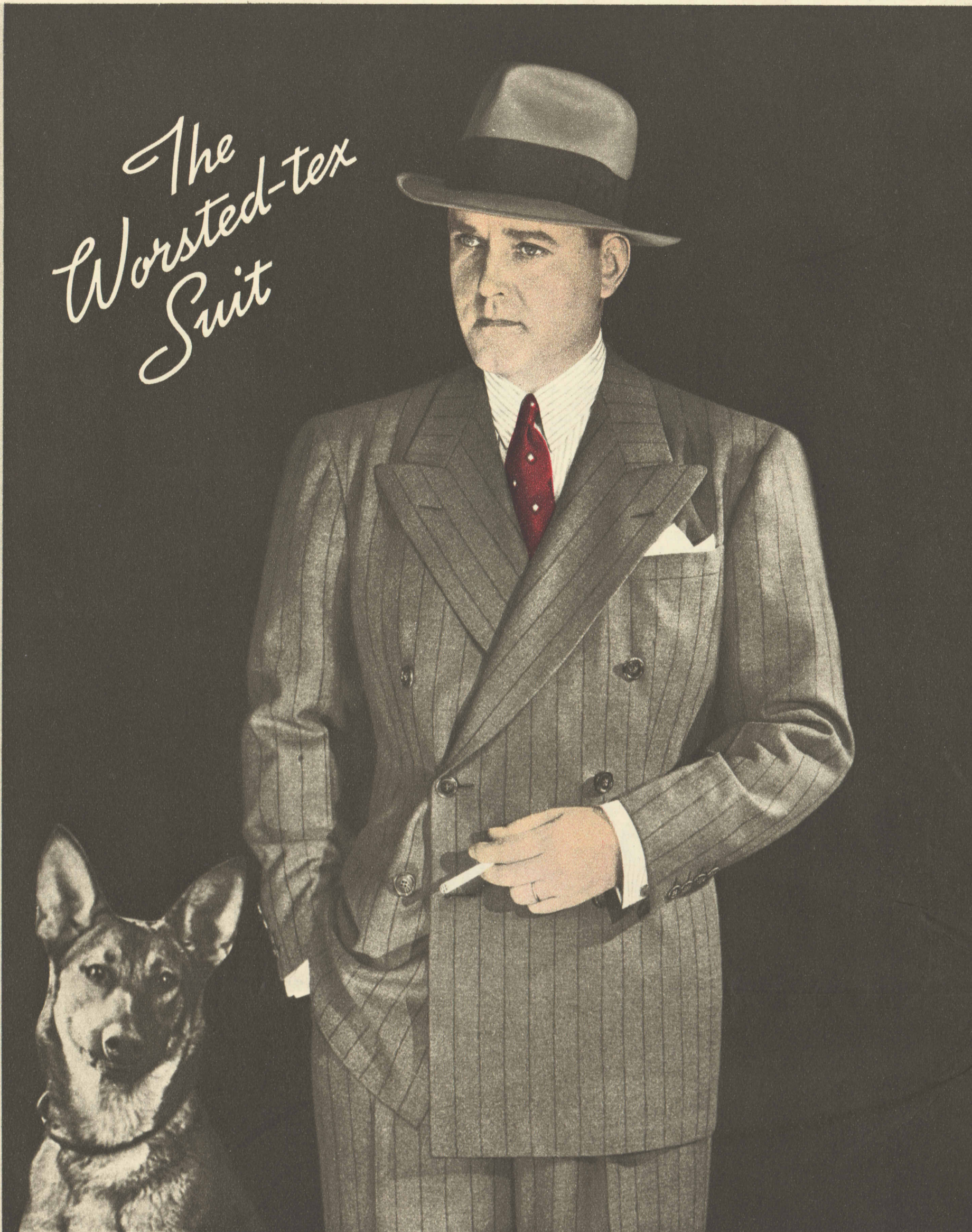

**A New Type of Suit That Makes Men Appear
Taller, Fuller-Chested and Slimmer at the Hips**

The man you see above, photographed in a British Lounge Model* is 5 feet 9" tall and weighs 165 pounds.

Notice what this model does for his figure. The slightly broader shoulders, the extra folds of fabric at the chest and the wider Horseshoe Collar* and lapels provide depth and an athletic look through the chest and across the shoulders.

Notice how the longer jacket, the lower waistline, the lower button placement, and the sweep of lapels give him the appear-

ance of added height.

Observe how the moulded lines of waist and hips seem to hug the figure and create a slender waist and hip effect; yet it is a surprisingly loose-fitting suit. It is a model that is flattering to almost every type of man.
