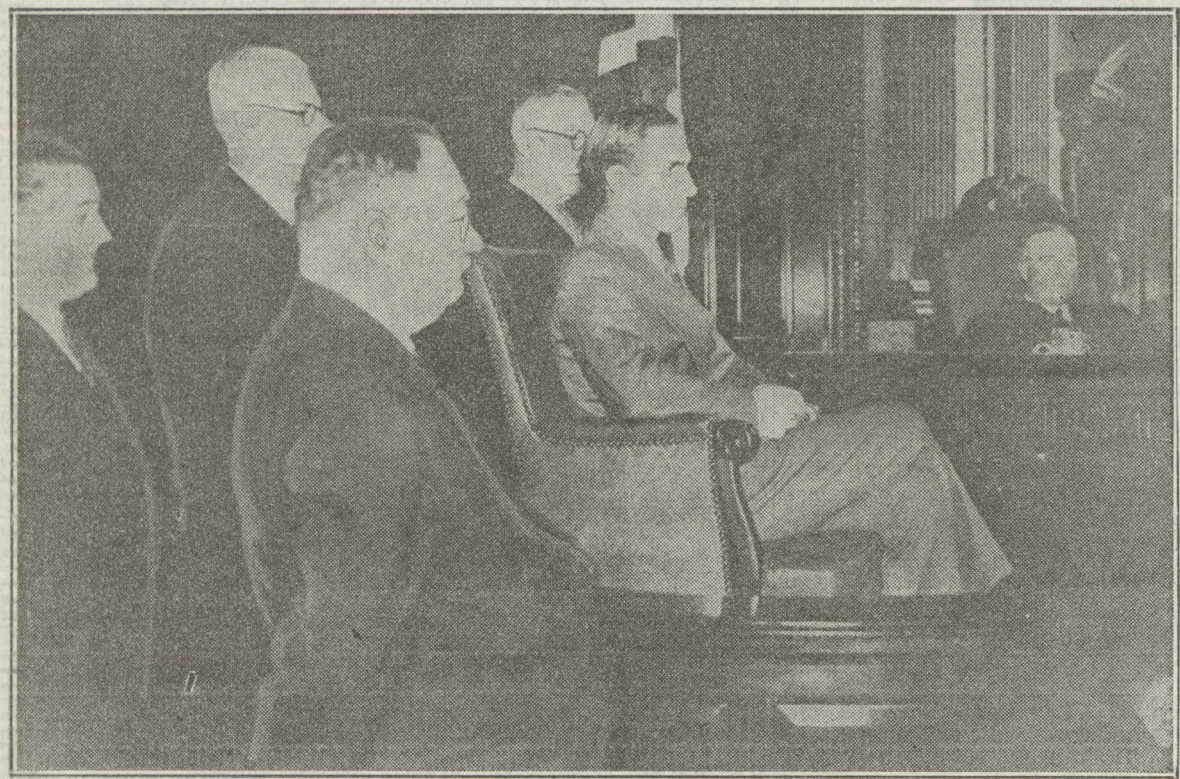
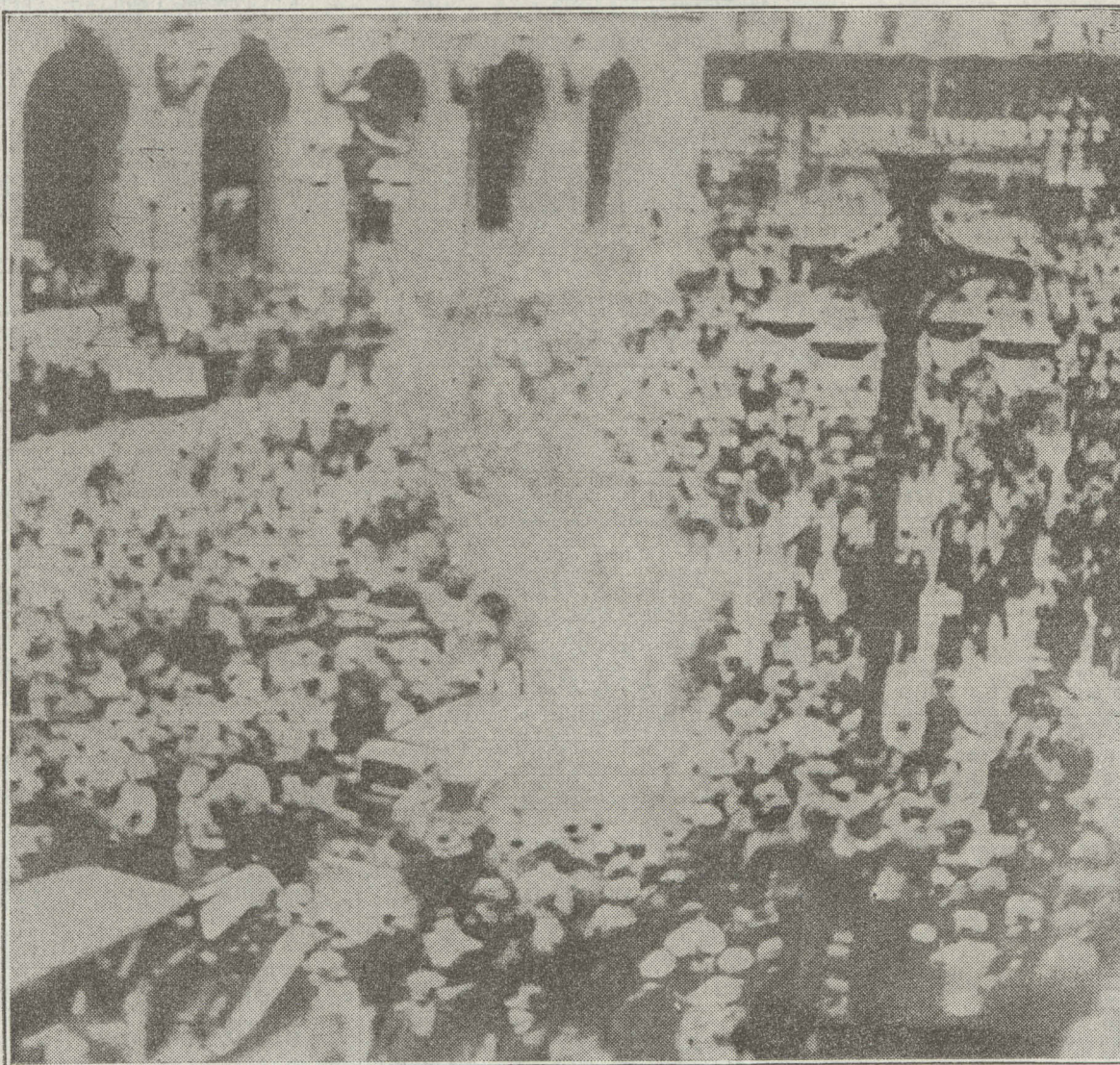


# Hauptmann Offers Alibi in Hearing on Extradition—Arrest Third Suspect in Assassination of King Alexander
