
These are babies with new homes awaiting them. Each child pictured here is under the care of one of three Chicago institutions—the Illinois Children's Home and Aid society. Child placement today is a problem, not of finding homes for babies, but of finding babies that are suitable for adoption, so far does the demand for them exceed the supply.
