Dear Mrs. Siehl:

I am delighted to submit the final report to you and to the parties involved. In our first formal fact finding hearing in Berrien County Court House, St. Joseph, Michigan, at 10 AM December 19, 1990, the parties reached a stipulated Fact Finding Agreement which was entered into the record by a MERC appointed Court Reporter. See copy of transcript attached.

The language in the transcript provides an outline of the sequence of events which took place during and following the pre-trial conference. These efforts culminated in a tentative agreement which was reached during the first formal fact finding hearing on 12/19/90, with the fact finder acting as mediator, at the request of the parties.

I am pleased to advise that the union membership ratified the new two year agreement on or about 2/8/91. The County Board approved the agreement in their meeting on 2/21/91. This brings this case to a successful conclusion.

By copy of this report I wish to express sincere appreciation to his honor Chief Probate Judge Franklin F. Meed, Mr. Gaylen McDonald of AFSCME and their respective bargaining teams. They all made responsible and difficult decisions.

I thank you and MERC for providing this interesting opportunity.

MR. KEREKES: This record is open in regard to MERC fact finding case number G89 K0747 at, 1:30 p.m. on December 19, 1990, at the Berrien County Courthouse at St. Joseph, Michigan.

The case involves an impasse in contract negotiations which has existed all during the course of 1990.

The parties met at a prehearing conference with the fact finder, Carl Kerekes, on 11-5-90.

The parties agreed to meet together in one last attempt to secure a new agreement prior to opening a formal fact finding hearing.

The parties met several times after

November 5 and achieved agreement, in principal, on all

of the unresolved issues, with the exception of wages

and length of new agreement.

A formal fact finding hearing was convened at St. Joseph, Michigan, on 12-19-90 with the following representatives in attendance:

12	On the 19th of December, 1990, the
13	parties, with the fact finder acting as a mediator,
14	continued to negotiate the issue of wages and length of
15	contract and reached substantial agreement.
16	That agreement is reproduced for the
17	record as follows:
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19	PROBATE COURT'S PROPOSAL
20	AFSCME SUPERVISORS
21	DECEMBER 19, 1990
22	1. LIFE INSURANCE: Increase life insurance to \$25,000
23	from \$20,000.
24	2. PENSION: Increase the multiplier to 2.0%
25	reducing to 1.7% upon receipt of full social

security benefits. Add "pop-up" provision which
"pop ups" the employee to the higher straight life
benefit amount if the employee has chosen a
survivor option and if the employee's spouse dies
before the former employer.

- 3. OVERTIME FOR JUVENILE CENTER WORKERS: The Court will formalize the policy which provides that Juvenile Center employees who are authorized to work in excess of 40 hours per week will receive straight comp. time for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours. This comp. time must be used within thirty days from the date earned.
- 4. VACATIONS: For new employees only, vacation cap of 225 hours established, and vacation earned by the following schedule:
 - 1 4 years 2 weeks
 - 5 14 years 3 weeks
 - 15 19 years 4 weeks
 - 20+ years 5 weeks

For those employees actively employed on January 1, 1991, accrual remains at 4 weeks per year. A vacation cap will be established as follows:

All current employees with less than 225 hours of unused vacation time shall have a maximum cap of 225 hours.

1	All current employees with more than 225
2	hours of unused vacation time as of December 1, 1990,
3	shall have an individual vacation cap equal to the
4	unused vacation hours that employee had on December 1
5	1990. That cap may be maintained by the employee as
6	long as he/she is employed by Probate Court.
7	5. ARBITRATION: The Court will prepare language to
8	allow for non-binding (advisory) arbitration for
9	all issues which currently are not arbitrible.
10	Regular arbitration (binding) still allowable for
11	all discharge and suspension actions.

Increase wages 4% over 1989 salary, wages: 6. effective December 1, 1990. In addition, all employees of this unit working on the date of ratification of the contract by both parties shall receive a \$500 signing bonus.

Effective March 9, 1991, the salary schedule (including the 5% steps) will be increased by 4% for all employees of this unit.

Contract expires December 31, 1991. DURATION: 7.

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That agreement was confirmed in a written counterproposal which was reviewed by the parties and initialed by the parties.

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1	The parties have requested this fact
2	finding record to be a stipulated agreement showing
3	agreement between Council 25, Local 2757 of AFSCME and
4	Chief Probate Judge Stuart F. Meek, Jr., of Berrien
5	County, with Mr. Gaylen McDonald signing for AFSCME.
6	This meeting is closed with the fact
7	finder and both parties stipulating that all parties
8	are in substantial agreement with respect to all
9	matters contained in the new tentative agreement.
10	The Union and the County pledge to work
11	out exact language of the new contract, which will be
12	submitted to the membership for ratification.
