FACT-FINDING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION:

In the Matter of the Contract Dispute between

THE CITY OF JACKSON and LOCAL #1306, IAFF - AFL-CIC

After study and review of the economic issues which separate the parties, it is apparent that, despite the Firemen's need for and right to expect equitable treatment by the Employer, the City of Jackson is suffering from a critical income squeeze which only the taxpayers of the community can relieve through favorable action in the pending Income Tax Referendum.

Giving full consideration to the straits in which the parties presently find themselves, the following recommendations are hereby submitted, with the urgent request that the parties adopt them as the solution for completing their Agreement:

- 1. The term of the Agreement shall be for Two (2) years, from July 1, 1968 to June 30, 1970.
- There shall be no wage increase in the first year of the contract but wages, only, shall be reopened on June 30, 1969.
- 3. The City shall increase the insurance coverage to \$5,000.00 effective with October, 1968.
- 4. The City shall buy the first clothing issue for new firemen and all firemen shall receive an \$80.00 clothing allowance thereafter. (Annually)
- 5. Vacations shall be improved by granting one (1) additional day to employees with Ten (10) or more years of seniority and with two (2) additional days after completing fifteen (15) years of service.
- 6. Each employee shall receive an annual subsistence allowance of Two-hundred Forty (\$240.00) Dollars.

7. The City shall pay the full cost of Family Blue Cross-Blue Shield, M-75 Plan, effective with October, 1968.
