On May 8, 2001 a pre-arbitration hearing took place by conference call to the parties. At that time the parties informed the Arbitrator that they had exchanged exhibit lists, agreed by stipulation that the above issues were outstanding and that the Panel Delegates would be Thomas Kreis for the Union and Patrick White for the Employer.

On May 16, 2001 the parties met in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan for a 312 hearing. The persons listed above were in attendance. The hearing began with informal discussion regarding the six unresolved issues. The Arbitrator served in the role of Mediator as the discussion progressed throughout the day.

The process concluded with tentative agreement on each of the above items. Both parties ratified the agreements and will either mail or fax the agreed upon language to the Arbitrator in the near future. Upon receipt of that language, the Arbitrator will forward the language to the Bureau.
