STIPULATIONS FOR ACT 312 ARBITRATION PROCEEDING

NOW COMES the parties, City of Warren (Employer), and Warren

Professional Fire Fighters Association, Local 1383 (Union), by and through each of their respective representatives and hereby stipulate to the resolution of the

following issues before the Act 312 Arbitration Panel which will remove these issues from the Arbitration and will be incorporated in the new Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties:

1. Issue: Article 7, Longevity-(Economic)

Amend Article 7, Section 2, of the CBA to provide for longevity pay caps as follows:

July 1, 1999 - \$30,000 July 1, 2002 - \$31,000

Local 1383 Members on the payroll upon issuance of the Award and all Local 1383 Retirees who retired on or after July 1, 1999 shall receive retroactive amounts.

2. Letter of Understanding

The Letter of Understanding regarding Promotions and Step-Asides will be placed in the Contract and will have the dates updated.

3. Issue: Article 26, Pension (Economic and Non-Economic)

- C. Amend Article 26, Section (M) to provide that eligible retirees shall receive a two hundred dollar (\$200.00) cost of living adjustment each year.
- D. The retiree cost of living adjustment to be retroactive to July 1, 1999.

4. Issue: Article 26, Pension (Residency)

Delete Section K - residency requirement.
