Anne Wirgau, Steward, Local #1325 Joanne Budnik, Secretary/Treasurer, Local #1325 Dorothy Darga, Chairperson, Local #1325 Charles Rhode, Presque Isle County Commissioner Emil Blath, Jr., Presque Isle County Commissioner After extensive on-the record and off-the record consultations and discussions with the Fact-Finder/Arbitrator and with each other, the parties arrived at the following:

STIPULATION

- Modify Article 33 to read: Single subscriber, \$58.60; two person, \$131.91; family, \$140.23.
- 2. Modify the letter of understanding regarding payment of health insurance costs to read, effective 1/1/87, single subscriber, \$67.55; two person, \$152.52; family, \$161.55. These amounts shall be paid retroactively to January 1, 1987, and employees who paid amounts covered by these payments shall be reimbursed. Effective 1/1/88, these amounts shall be increased to single subscriber, \$71.09; two person, \$160.90; family, \$169.11.
- 3. Modify Article 43 (d) Workday, by revising Subsection (d) to read as follows:
 - (d) The above is merely a definition of the workday. The work schedule and the starting and quitting times for any and all shifts shall be established by the Sheriff. Work schedules shall be posted at least one (1) week in advance whenever possible; provided, however, that the Sheriff reserves the right to change the work schedule where circumstances require that it be changed. In the event that the posted work schedule is required to be changed, the Sheriff will endeavor to give at least twenty-four (24) hours advance notice of such changes.
- 4. Modify Article 29, Equalization of Overtime, by adding the following: The provisions of the foregoing notwithstanding, the employer shall call part-time employees within the classification affected prior to offering the work to full-time employees.

5. Increased wages across the board effective the first full pay period on or after January 1, 1987, twenty cents per hour. On or after the first full pay period after January 1, 1988, fifteen cents per hour. The increase of twenty cents shall be paid retroactively.

The above stipulation is hereby adopted as its final and binding Award by the Board of Arbitration.
