Preliminary Fact-Finding Recommendation

In the matter of the con tract dispute between the

The Adrian Board of Education and The Adrian Education Association

After study and review of the differences separating the parties from complete agreement, the following broad recommendation is proposed as the basis for consummating an equitable and endurable overall settlement.

- 1. The Board's proposals, as set forth in its exhibit #1, shall be accepted by the Association as part of the total agreement, and
- 2. In addition, the Board shall make available a total sum of eighty thousand (\$80,000) dollars, above and beyond the economic value of the items set forth in the Board's package proposal (exhibit #1) which shall be accepted by the Association in full and complete settlement of all demands, differences and disputes heretofore barring agreement, and, further
- 3. Said lump-sum settlement appropriation of \$80,000 shall be allocated in accordance with reasonable recommendations of the Association, provided that, under no circumstances, shall the aggregate total of such allocations exceed the fixed ceiling of \$80,000 hereby made available expressly to achieve complete agreement.

The foregoing recommendation is given to the parties with the urgent request that each shall agree to accept this formula for submission to their respective principals with good-faith endorsement of ratification.
