ARTICLE I

Recognition

Michigan State University The Ishpering Township Seard of Maucation recognizes the Ishpening Township Chapter of the M. E. A. as the exclusive negotiation representative for cortificated personnel in the District.

ASTICLE II

Teacher Rights

A. Fursuant to Act 379 of the Public Acts of 1965, the Board hereby agrees that every exployee of the Board shall have the right freely to organize, join, and support the Asso clation for the purpose of e gaging in collective bargaining or negotiation and other concerted activities for mutual aid and protection.

ARTIGLE III

Professional Compensation

The salaries of teachers sust be based on the following Ao salary schedule approved by both teachers and Board of Education:

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Super-Med health insurance in full shall be provided for the personnel.

- 6. Teachers shall be further compensated for duties outside their contractual teaching duties. The amount to be paid shall be specified by the Board of Education.
- D. Salaries shall be paid on alternate Thursdays with 26 payments a year.
- E. New teachers shall be given up to ten years of cradit for teaching outside of the District.

ARTICLE IN

Teaching Genélitions

- A. Teachers will report to achool by 8:15 and may leave by 3:30.
- B. The Board of Education shall make every effort to limit teacher-pupil ratio to less than 35 1.
- C. Teachers shall not be required to perform non-teaching duties, such as selling of lunch tickets
- D. Telephone facilities shall be made available for their reasonable use.
- E. Teachers shall be entitled to full rights of citizenship. There shall be no discrimination as to race or religion.

ARTICLE V

Leaves of Absence with Pay

- A. All teachers absent from duty on account of personal illness shall be allowed full pay for a total of ten days per year. This sick leave shall be accusulative to 90 days.
- 3. Two days per year will be granted for personal business for a reasonable request at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- C. Sick leave days can be extended to include days absent due to death in the immediate family (father, mother, sister, brother, husband, wife, daughter, som). The number of days granted shall be left to the discretion of the Superintendent.
- D. Trachers shall be given isave of assence for equcational conferences and in-service braining upon approval of the Superinkersiont and the Board of Education

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E. Upon retirement from the District or desth while an active teacher in the District, the teacher or the teacher's beaeficiary, shall receive the following payment. The accumulated number of days of unused sick leave gradited to the teacher, times one-half the current daily salary of a substitute teacher is the District.

Teachers shall designate a beneficiary for this plan.

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Teacher Evaluation

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- A. All teacher evaluation must be done with fairness and in a professional manner.
- B. The Professional Megotiations Committee shall act as a Grievance Committee between the Ishpening Township Chapter of the M.E.A. and the Ishpening Township Board of Education.

ARTICLE VII

Teacher Regulresents

- A. Teachers' certificates must be duly registered with the Intermediate Superintendent of Schools.
- B. All teachers are required to have a yearly chest x-ray and found free of toperoutesis. These x-rays are to be free of cost to the individual teacher.
- C. The retirement age of the teaching staff is 65.

ARTICLE VIII

Teaching Assignments

- A. The assignments of teaching positions shall be at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- B. Teachers shall be subject to t ansfer from position to position when necessary at the discretion of the Superintendent.

ARTICLE IX

Professional Dues or Fees and Payroll Deductions

A. Any teacher who is a member of the Association, or who has applied for membership, may sign and deliver to the Board of Educations of Ishpening Township an assignment authorizing deduction of membership dues in the Association, including the MEA and the MEA, for the school year of 1971-72. Pursuant to such authorization, the Board shall deduct one-tenth of such dues from a regular salary check of the teacher each month for ten month peginning in September and ending in June.

ARTICLE X

School Calendar for the 1971-72 School Year A. The school year shall have 182 session days

ARTICLE XI

Amendments and Teralmation

A. This contract shall remain in force until August 31,1972 at 12 9'clock midnight. It may be meended by the agreement of the same parties who estered into it originally.
