ARTICLE XXIV

This agreement shall be effective as of August 26, 1985, and shall continue in effect for two years until August 23, 1987. This agreement shall not be extended orally and it is expressly understood that it shall expire on the date here indicated. However, upon mutual consent of both parties to the agreement, renegotiation of part or all of this agreement may take place at any time during the term of this contractual agreement.

LANGUAGE CHANGES

ARTICLE V

H. 180 Day Instruction Rule

In accordance with Section 101 of the School Aid Act, teachers need not report to work on days when pupil instruction is not provided because of conditions not within the control of school authorities such as severe storms, fires, epidemics, mechanical failure, or health conditions as defined by the city, county or state. Days of instruction lost for the above reasons will be made up at the end of the school year and teachers will report for work.

ARTICLE XI

Leave Policy

K. The Board shall grant a leave without pay, benefits, or increment for child care to any teacher under the following conditions:
