LETTER FROM BEYADA
CAREY GOTT, Nov. 27, 1872
I have nothing to do in it. I will write you a few lines to tell you that we are all well, and arrived home one week ago to-morrow. We were four weeks and four days from the time we left your place, Manchester, until we reached home. We stayed one day at Chicago, and one day at Omaha. So you see, by this, we were not away from you on the plains, and I can assure you it was the longest four weeks I ever spent in my life, however, we were not with little suffering, as far as eatables was concerned. When we were where we could buy our meals we do so, but that was not often, and whenever I could buy anything in the shape of bread, or some food, I did so, and I can assure you it was a very good business. He treated us to a buggy ride about the city, and pointed out all the principal places of interest. The city is located on a very level tract of land and is surrounded by rich farming and population. The appearance presented by the entire place was cheerful and pleasant, but we supposed that flowers and leaves will add to its beauty and attractiveness in the future. We had but little attention paid to manufacturing interests, but we understood that parties were negotiating the matter of starting works of some kind in this region.
