The industrial crisis in Germany grows worse, and destitution is spreading with significant rapidity. A deputy recently stated in the Reichstag that actual famine was impending in the Giant Mountains, Silesia. In Berlin a committee has been formed to initiate measures of relief, and other cities and towns have asked permission to begin important public works to give employment to the poor.

Execution of Lee. John D. Lee, who led the Mountain Meadows massacre in the month of September, 1859, was executed at the scene of the murder on March 23, at ten p. m. he was brought out before the executing party, and seated on his coffin, about twenty feet from the spot. After the order of the court had been read to him and the company present by Marshal Nelson, Lee made a speech of about five hundred words, bitterly denouncing Brigham Young, and calling upon the spectators for vengeance on him. He begged God would be merciful. He stated that he was guilty of bloodshed in the past, and maintained that his mission to the Meadows was one of mercy. Immediately after this a handkerchief was placed over his eyes, and he was then sitting down. Nelson gave the word to fire, and exactly six shots of black powder were fired, penetrating the body in the region of the heart. Lee fell back upon his coffin, dead. Death was instantaneous.
