On the 20th of May he sailed for the Strait of Bering, entirely beyond the reach of danger, and on the 21st of June, on which date he was to sail into the Pacific and out for home by way of Bering Strait. In the course of the innumerable attempts to find a north-east passage, and his achievement is one of the most extraordinary of the century.
