Wreck on the Rail.
An extra passenger train collided with a
freight on the Vaudeville Line at Clear Creek
Trestle, nine miles west of Terre Haute on the
24th inst. The extra was two hours and fifteen
minutes late, but the conductor reports "two
lost lives and a business meeting." At
the point where the collision occurred there
was a sharp curve, and a trestle about forty-five
feet high, approached by high embankments.
When the engine struck part of the passenger
train was on the trestle, and the two postal
cars and baggage cars were precipitated below,
as were also the locomotives. The express and
passenger cars and sleepers did not leave the
track. The engineer, James Watson, and the
fireman of the freight stopped before the
collision. The former had his arm broken,
shoulder dislocated and sustained internal
injuries, to what extent not yet known. Lyman
Booth, a brakeman on the freight, had his leg
mangled below the knee, and is bruised and
scalded on the head. In the passenger train
Miss Hannah, the engineer, and W. T. Seaman,
the fireman, were buried beneath the
wreck and instantly killed. William Hunt,
Ernest Umbrosl and Benjamin Delahunt,
both clerks, were seriously injured, the latter
having his legs broken near the trunk. None
of the passengers were injured.

Return of Lieut. Schwatka's Expedition
from the North.

sailed from New York, June 19, 1878, for Hud-
son's Bay and King William's Land for the
purpose of seeking further details upon the fate
of Sir John Franklin, though the special object
of the search is the recovery of the remains of
the Franklin party, which, according to the Equip-
ment testimony, were known to exist at a
specified point in the bay.
