Taming Wild Horses.

If there are no wild horses riding in the range, horses are easy to tame, more so than cattle. One of the tamer will make all the horses wild. He will see him or hear him, and then during the labor of driving them into the corral and of handling them after they are in. The colts of the mares I use usually four or five. I break to the halter and to bring him in. I will usually use a lasso—a rope with a noose in the end—over the head of the one I wish to capture, letting go of the rope as soon as the noose is drawn snug. There is a crowd of horses in the corral, so that none shall become entangled in it. After the horses quiet down we will drive to the corral, which is thirty or forty feet long, and often we attach another rope to the first one. We then begin pulling toward the center of the corral and let the horse run around us with the crowd, being careful to avoid being entangled in the rope. We drop the rope whenever other horses are likely to trouble us by their movements.

Chinese Funerals.

Of all the multifarious ceremonies and propitiation which regulate the social intercourse and daily life of the Chinese, there is none so scrupulously performed as the obsequies of their higher relatives. The infant may be laid in some corner to grow away its little life and finally wrapped in matting and be dropped into the river or buried like a dog in the back garden, but great is the pomp and admiration of the ceremonies consequent upon the decease of one who has lived long enough to rear a son. If that son is poor he will pawn his personal effects, stint himself of food, borrow money at exorbitant rates of interest, and if there is no other security he will pawn a wife, a child, or even sell his own body as a slave so as to raise sufficient money to defray the cost of his parent's funeral. Confucian treats call this by the name of filial piety, though everybody knows that in the majority of cases the underlying motive is a self-interest born of the most debasing superstition. The man believes that the least omission of the orthodox funeral rites will bring the most terrible calamities upon him and his posterity; that he will be haunted until the last moment of his life by the unhappy ghost of his departed sire, or in fancy hear the angry voice of his neglected parent pouring curses upon his head wherever he goes. He accordingly observes every minute custom in order to avert these evils and give repose to the spirit of the dead. Let us suppose the last hour has come and the venerable one, whom a score of doctors have tried in vain to cure, is lying on a cot or mat, with his feet toward the door, ready for his last journey. His best robes, hat and shoes are brought out, for all these articles will be needed when he crosses the chill border-land of the other world. A piece of two of silver is put into the dying man's mouth, for this, too, will be needed to pay the toll. The grim ferryman. These preliminaries over, a look of dismay, but rather a smile that such loving provision is made for his long journey. When the last gasps come that usher death, the eldest son approaches and closes his father's eyes, or perhaps orders the opening of a hole in the roof to facilitate the departure of the three spirits of the living man. Life is hardly extinct before the eldest son or nearest relative issues forth to buy water, related by musicians. He carries a bowl to the nearest river or well, where he deposits a few cash for the water dragon. With this so-called purchased water he proceeds to wash the corpse and then decks it in the costliest and most elaborate robes worn in life. Buddhist or Taoist figures, carved in broad-cast silk, are called in to chant the proscribed litanies, to break open purgatory, to cast the dead man's horoscope, to say what form, whether of man or beast or bird, the dead man assumes in his migration to happier realms, or even procure him a passport to the Western Paradise. At the door of the house is erected an awning, hung with blue lanterns and streamers of blue and white paper, the outward manifestations to passers-by of a house of mourning and death. Inside the house preparations are made for confining the corpse. Meats and delicacies are placed upon the table, and lamps, incense, and candles are lighted around the dead. A Chinese coffin resembles the trunk of a tree planed off, and is made of the hardest wood procurable. So expensive are the coffins that the wood for one will sometimes cost as much for a pig, and no coffin would think of paying less than \$25 for his father's case. One of the most appropriate presents for a father sixty years of age is considered to be a coffin. He addresses the aged one in words which may be familiarly translated: "Daddy, I don't want your tomb, but your box is ready when you want to go," and the old man receives the gift with unbounded gratitude. Relatives and friends, men and women, every visitor, proud to possess such a token of his son's filial duty. The coffin, therefore, is usually near at hand. When the corpse is ready it is solemnly removed to the coffin by hired attendants, while others proceed to beat the floor to terrify evil spirits from the dwelling. A corona of gold or silver, bracelets, earrings, chains, watches and other ornaments of gold, silver and jewels, are put upon the body, according to the rank and sex of the deceased. With a fan in one hand and a written prayer in the other, the corpse is now ready for the world of shades. The deceased is then covered with a white silk shroud or coverlet, presented by relatives and friends, those not used being committed to the flames through which they are said to pass to the world below. The nearest relative then presents the mat to the undertaker and builds the coffin while it is nailed down and hermetically sealed. A given signal, the lamentations begin, the women wailing and men howling till they are nearly hoarse, the amount of tears shed by different relatives being limited by strict regulations. The hollowness of the whole performance is seen when some new-comer arrives. In a moment he will lay his hands before the exchange of compliments. Having taken breath, he comes another weep-up, more vigorously than before.

How Much To Eat.

About the theory of diet I do not mean to say very much in this place. The theory of diet is a complicated thing, and by no means completely understood as yet. Authorities differ, or even quarrel, some contradicting each other; and even for the physician it is a tedious thing to find his way through the labyrinth of theories and half-certainties in which he must study the contemporary doctrines of dietetics. Still there are some things which are certain, but ignorantly denied, and some things which are commonly accepted which are certainly false. About these facts and fallacies a few words will be in place, and I will say little about the history, the chemistry or the physiology of the subject. It does not concern us to be reminded again that roast beef is nutritious, that a varied diet is the best, that the azotized substances contain three proximate elements, or that lentils were eaten by Pharaoh Necho. The following points will be found, I trust, more to our purpose.
