larly during the winter period,
is a matter of the highest im-
portance, and, fourth, over-feeding
the horses during winter, as well as
over-feeding them during the summer.

Our climate is naturally dry and arid,
and the horses are naturally of a
lean constitution, and they have
not had the rich feed which they
have in the East. The most successful
breeders, therefore, feed their horses
openly both in winter and in summer,
and the outside tempera-
ture ranges about 25° except when
there is some severe cold. The tempera-
ture of the stable air, thousands of
miles inland from the coast, is
about 60°. The horses have been
destroyed in this country by the application of
too much grain. Many of them come from
distances 10,000 or 12,000 feet above the
sea level.

The plants should be kept clean
and free from all parasites, but
plants of such kind are the best pro-
tection against them. While such
plants are available, they should
be used. Every orchard should
be sponged with clean water two or
three times a year, so that the insects
may not have a chance to breed.
