Arbor Day Proclamation.
Arbor Day will occur on Monday, the 25th inst. Gov. Luce has issued a proclamation which designates the day and gives several excellent reasons for its observance, closing as follows:
I therefore respectfully and earnestly recommend that by the college, the mansion, in the cemetery, or in such other places as may be chosen, a tree may be planted on Monday, the 25th day of April, inst. by every person in our state with whom it is possible. And that it may be done with a more united purpose, I would suggest that each tree be dedicated to the memory of some friend, whose deeds of kindness or heroism you would keep green. And it is with confidence grown from the past, that I sincerely hope a people, unsurpassed in intelligence, unexcelled in public spirit, loyal to friends and benefactors, and proud of the best heritage in the family of states, will on that day add ornaments to the blessing of posterity, that only the seasons can finish for enjoyment.

Clouds Which Produce Rain.
A communication to the London Meteorological Society by Capt. Toyne states as his conclusion that clouds of not less than 2,000 feet in thickness are seldom accompanied by rain, or if they are, it is very gentle—consisting of minute drops; with a thickness of between 2,000 and 4,000 feet, the size of the drops is moderate; with increasing thickness of the clouds comes at the same time the degree of temperature becomes lowered. When the thickness amounts to more than 6,000 feet hail is produced.—Chicago Times.
