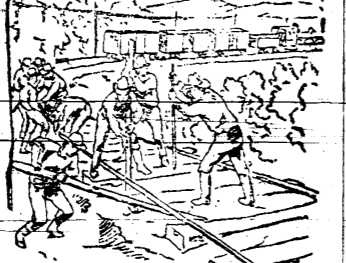
The expedition, in the daring of its inception, had the address of a romance, while in the gigantic and overwhelming results it brought about it was like a dramatic scene.

At length we reached the Etowah river and safely passed over the great bridge at that point. No stop was made, though the first serious cause for anxiety was here visible.

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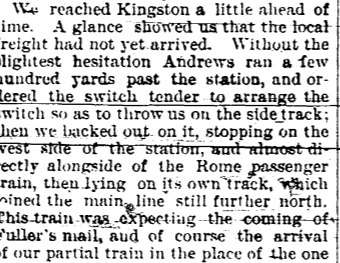
Before sunrise became intolerable the whistle of an approaching train was heard, and the local freight rumbled up to the eastern side of the depot and stopped on the main track.

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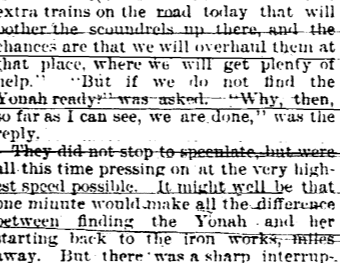
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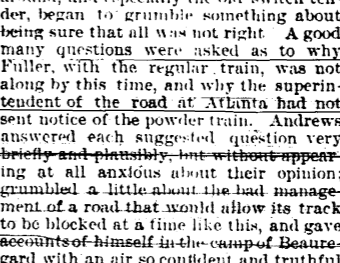
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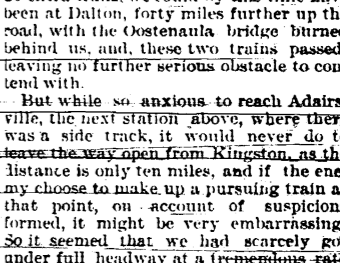
