LESSON VI, SECOND QUARTER, INTERNATIONAL SERIES, MAY 11.

Text of the Lesson, Luke ix, 10-17—Commentary Verses 16, 17—Golden Text, John vi, 35—Commentary by the Rev. D. M. Stearns.

The sending forth of the twelve, and the beheading of John the Baptist, briefly referred to in the opening verses of this chapter...

"And the people, when they knew it, followed him: and Jesus said that Jesus crossed the Sea of Galilee, and the people followed because they saw His miracles...

"And He received them." Matthew and Mark both say that He was met with great compassion toward them. No pity for Himself, but full of pity for these sheep without a shepherd...

"And spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing." Both body and soul He attended to, for He is a Saviour for both...

"Send the multitude away." So said the twelve as the day began to wear away, and as they, weary and hungry, saw no prospect of rest...
