THE FLATTENED BULLET



It is a hot summer evening in July, 1765, and the setting sun is looming sullenly through the rolling smoke that covers the field of Kunersdorf.

The fiercest battle of the Seven Years' war has been fought and the victor's struggle began the evening of the 13th of August, 1763. Prussia seems wrecked beyond redemption.

Of 48,000 men who gathered around the standards of Frederick the Great this morning barely 3,000 remain together.

Marshal Soltikoff is scribbling on a drumhead his triumphant dispatch to the Empress Elizabeth: "Your majesty's enemies are annihilated," and Frederick himself, with despair in his heart and a hand clenched convulsively upon the little phial of poison which is his last resource against adverse fortune, is galloping wildly hither and thither in a fruitless effort to rally his beaten host.

Could anyone have shown to the despairing king at that bitter moment a vision of his "annihilated" Prussia as she should be a century later, with Russia courting her alliance, and France and Austria prostrate at her feet, he would have been sorely amazed; but for the time the greatness of her present peril hides the splendor of her coming deliverance.

And well it may; for one glance at the field of battle suffices to show that all is lost.

The batteries stormed so irresistibly this morning are once more crowded with white-coated Austrian grenadiers.

The dark-blue mass of the Prussian column is ebbing back in a thousand scattered streams like a broken wave, the long white lines of the Austrian battalions overlapping it like wreaths of spray; while gray and shadowy in the background loom the vast masses of the Russian infantry, rallying for the second time to the stubborn courage of their race to victory and to vengeance.

Last in the field, as the swarming destroyers came raging on, stand two battalions of Prussian guards—a little islet of stout manhood in that roaring sea of ruin.

They are prepared to die, if die they must; but alas they will sell their lives dearly. And so they do.

Loudon's dragoons on the right, Balthayn's hussars on the left, storm in upon them like a whirlwind, but all in vain.

Falling fast on every side, the indomitable handful still close sternly up to make up good their impregnable square.

Spines ever looms out the line of grim faces behind their hedge of steel, from which bursts ever and anon the flash and crack of the fatal musketry.

Without hesitating a moment he pulled out the flattened ball, and holding it up to the king, said quietly: "This watch, sire, keeps but one time—it tells me that I must be ready at any hour to die for my majesty."

Frederick shot a glance at the malicious Frenchman, before which the latter recoiled as from a blow, and then taking off his watch, said with a look of emotion rarely seen on that iron face:

"Take this, my old comrade, as the gift not of your king but of your friend, and to-morrow you shall see that I have not forgotten the field of Kunersdorf."

And sure enough the very next morning Colonel Hasfeldt received a pension which made him comfortable for life.

A COLORED PREACHER.

A Vivid Word Picture of the Last Day and Its Startling Effect.

"The most wonderful sermon I ever heard," said a business man to a writer, "was delivered by a colored preacher in South Carolina, in a slave pen which was being utilized as a church shortly after the war. I happened to drop into the large gathering of colored people one night and was informed that a new preacher was about to be tried. The minister arose back of a pulpit that had been improvised from a barrel turned bottom upward, on which was a lighted candle stuck in a bottle. He began to read the bible, but stumbled at every word, spelling some throughout before pronouncing them. A man in the rear said: 'Go ahead with your sermon, and he stood at full length, and in the dim, flickering light of the lone candle looked more like an apparition than a man. His subject was 'The Judgment.' Here came in that wonderful imaginative quality for which the colored race is noted. In going about during the war he had become imbued with the military spirit, so he began by giving a vivid word picture, of the hosts of heaven lying in their tents asleep the night before the judgment day. Then he worked up to a point where the bugle sounded to prepare for the descent upon the sinful world. He pictured the heavenly hosts hurriedly running out of their tents to form in line of battle with the great commander in front. Then he described the stillness that reigned when all was ready, awaiting the command to advance. By this time the whole congregation, including myself, were sitting with nerves strained, excited in the extreme, and as the preacher described the tramp, tramp, tramp of the mighty host approaching the earth I saw several members, terrified, get down under the benches. He then followed a courier coming from the distance, who reported 'Death on a white horse' as having appeared far away. When the preacher described the commander detaching a squad of his soldiers to go capture death, a terrified moan came from the audience. Finally he brought the army of heaven down to earth just before daybreak, and had them resting on their arms awaiting Gabriel's trumpet. He pictured at length how quiet everything was, and then putting his hand to his mouth he imitated the bugle call, which so terrified and completely unstrung his audience that the greater portion of it, those unfortunates, rushed out of the building. In all my life I have never heard of a sermon that had such a startling effect upon a congregation."

An Epidemic of Single Legs.
