# The Canal Across the Republic of Nicaragua.

## Its Early Completion Now a Certainty. How It Will Affect Commerce.—Description of the Proposed Great Inter-Oceanic Waterway.

President Cleveland, by promptly recognizing the treaty, on coming into the presidency in 1885, quite sustained the British contention.

Today some of the most learned international lawyers in the United States maintain that the old treaty is valid and binding, at the same time confessing the content belief that in all probability Great Britain is quite as willing that it should be abrogated in the proper way, relinquishing her right under it to share in the construction, control and protection of a maritime canal through Nicaragua, as the United States are to have it done.

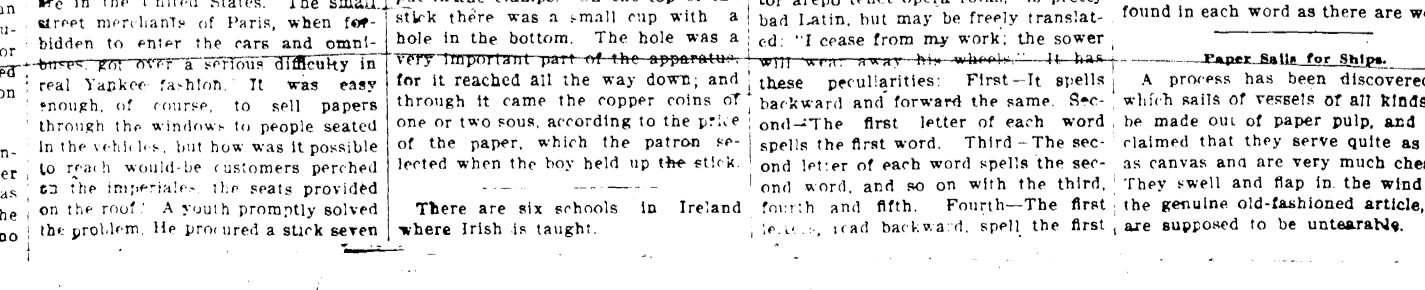
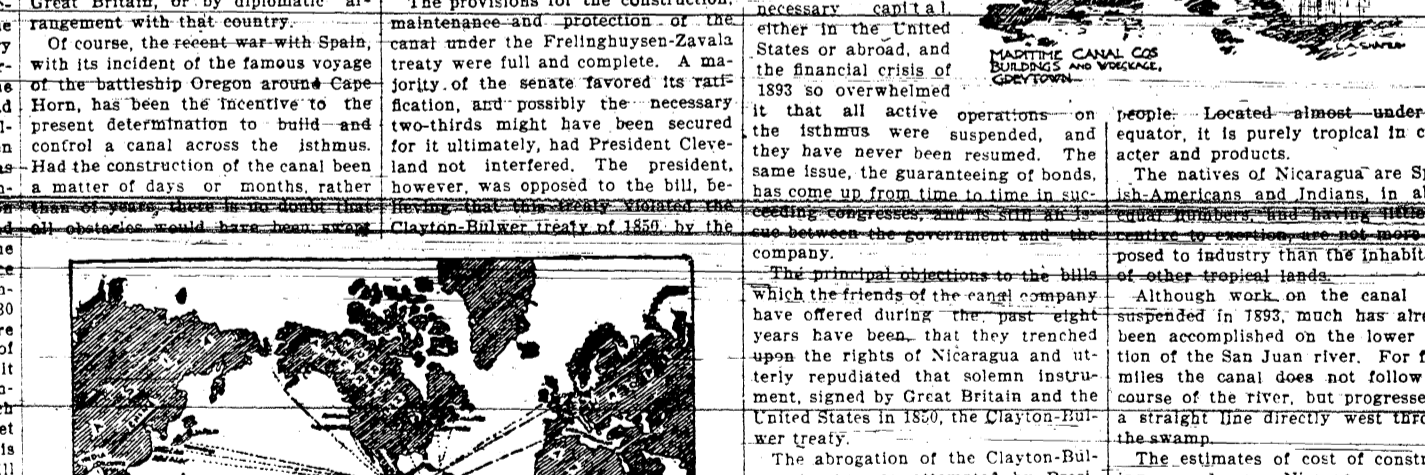
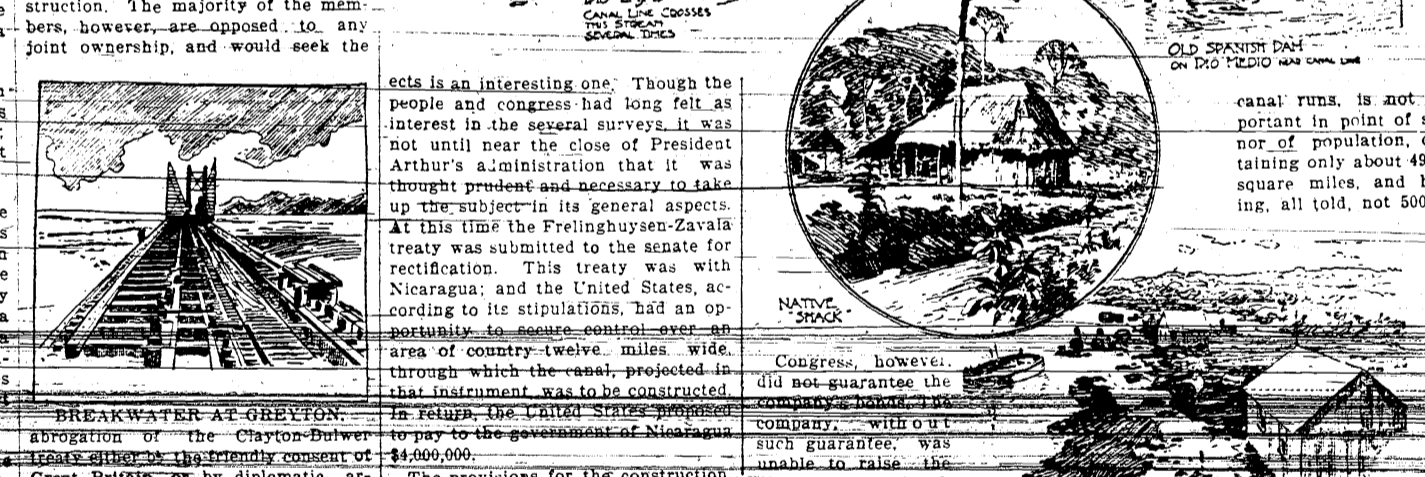
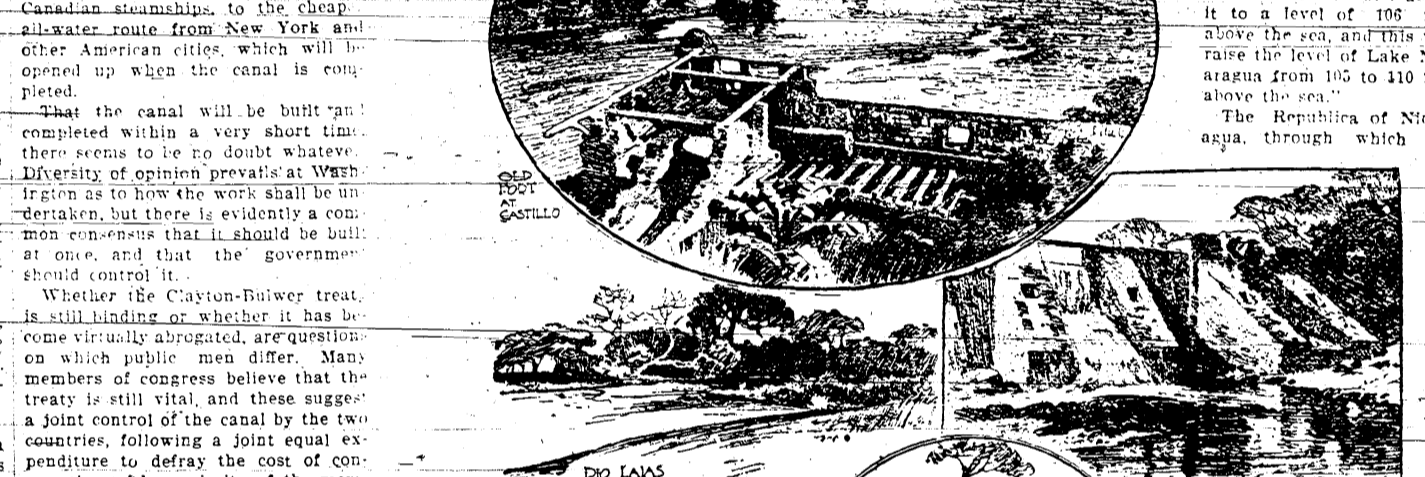
