May Sample Chop Suet... Grand Rapids follows through with its plan to sample chop suet.

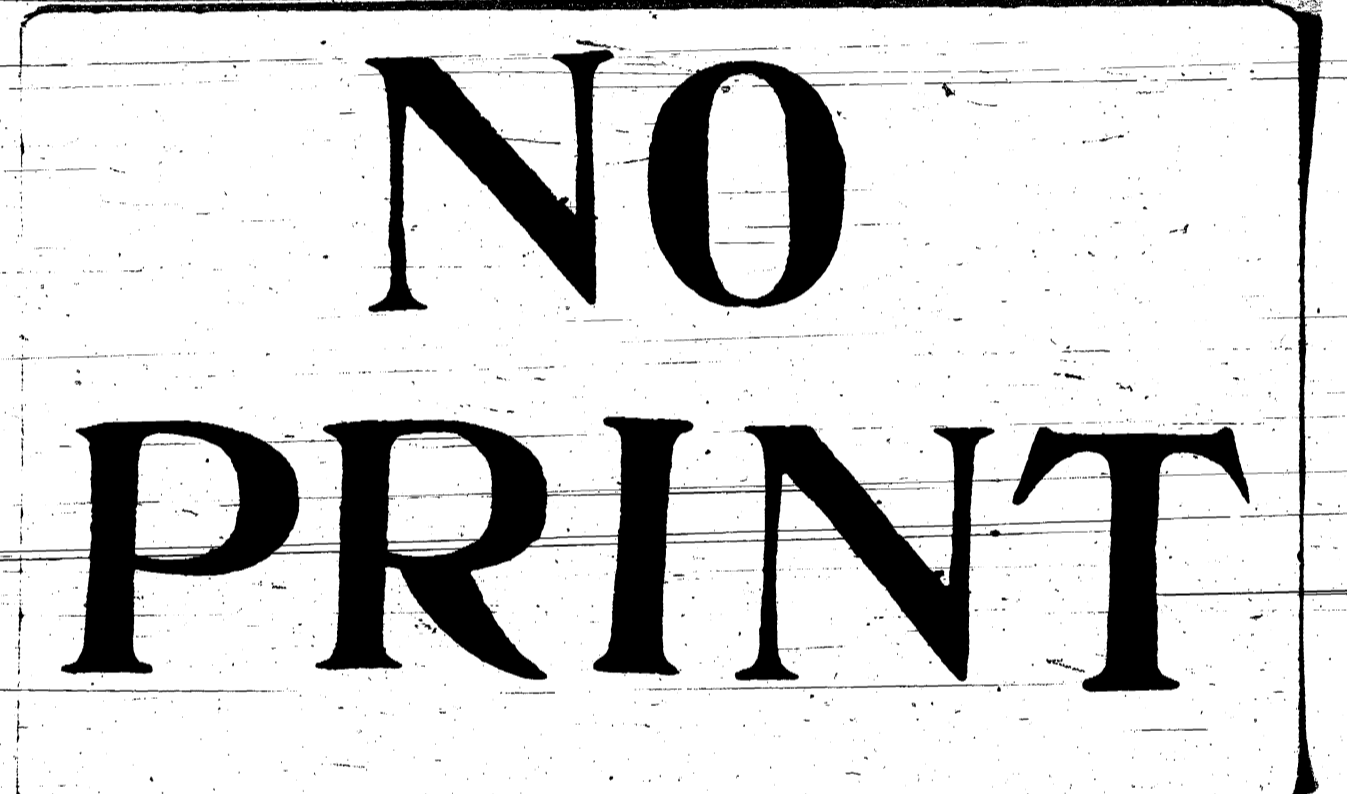

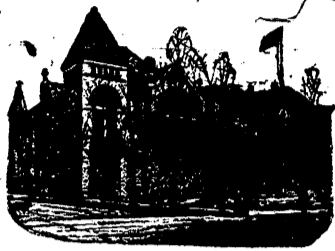
