From a bottled dinner when the cabbage is soaked in the pot with the meat. The cabbage should be soaked in water for a few hours before it is used.

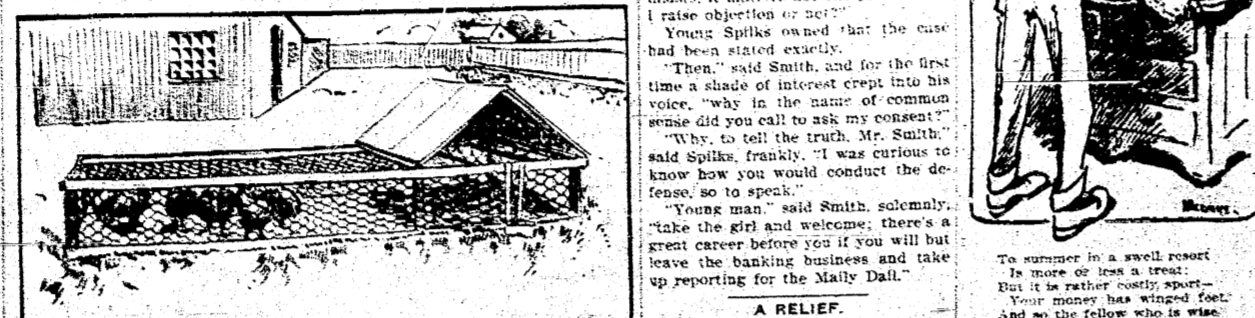
MARKING THE PIES.

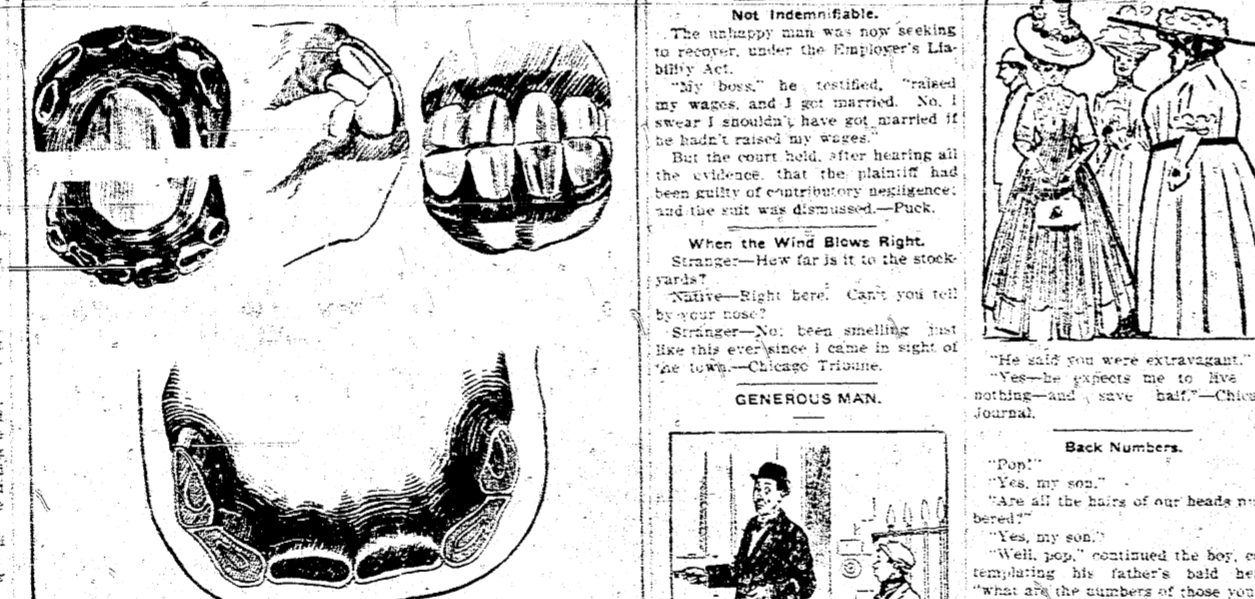


Good Type of Movable Wire Coop.

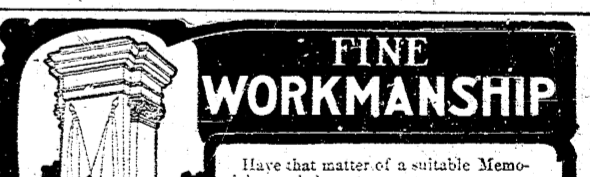
