School Column.

In this first issue for the school year of '97-'98, the "School Column" brings to its readers suggestions with reference to the needs of the district schools.

The first day of school is the keynote of the year. The old proverb "Well begun is half done" holds true in school teaching as in other things.

Fore-warned is fore-armed. The teacher will be on the school grounds a few days before school begins; will have studied the classification register.

Again the thoughtful teacher, like "Amy Kelly" in the "Evolution of Dodd" will give some consideration to the condition of the school house and surroundings.

A copy of the State Manual and Course of Study should be in every school house, as well as child study circulars and pamphlets on the teaching of communicable diseases.
