


About an hour after our work started, the predicted snow started to drop. And drop. And drop some more. The majority of our sod laying was done in the snow. One way of refocusing is to attend the MAGCS Annual Superintendents' Winter Workshop. This year's winter workshop will once again be held at the Midwest Golf House in Lemont. The theme will center on career advancement and professional development. This year's organizers have lined up two industry leaders to speak.

In the morning attendees will have the pleasure of hearing Mr. Bruce Williams, CGCS, deliver his talk entitled, "Preparing for the Interview." Williams was born in Evergreen Park, Illinois and spent many hours of his early life on the grounds of the Beverly Country Club. After graduating from Michigan State University, he spent the next twenty-two years at the Bob O'Link Golf Club in Highland Park, Illinois. Twenty of those years were spent as the course superintendent. Currently, Williams is the Director of Grounds at the Los Angels Country Club, where he has been for twelve seasons. During his career Bruce has trained and coached over 140 men and women who have gone on to become superintendents. Topics covered in his talk will include: how to prepare, methods and tactics, and how to make yourself the most attractive candidate for the job. It will be a great learning experience for everyone in attendance.

The afternoon session will be run by incoming GCSAA President, Mr. Dave Downing, CGCS. Downing is the Vice President of Operations/Construction for the Signature Golf Group.
