USING LAWN PATCH FOR TURF REPAIR Kathy Hilbert Amturf Seeds Brighton, MI

Established over 60 years ago, Amturf Seeds evolved through the purchasing, cleaning, and resale of clover seed. Amturf Seeds has been involved in turfgrass for some 30 years. They became involved in turfgrass through Ken Hilbert's initiative to take a turfgrass class at Michigan State University.

Lawn Patch is a combination product containing grass seed, fertilizer, and a paper based mulch. After this product was developed in 1987, Amturf Seeds went to the National Hardware Show in Chicago, Illinois, where a marketing effort was established through the United States.

Lawn Patch is great for repairing spots, because in addition to soil, water, and sunlight, all the elements needed for a successful planting are in one package.

Lawn Patch comes in several mixtures: Bluegrass Mix (this is straight Kentucky Bluegrass); Sunny Mix (mixture of bluegrass, ryegrass and fescue); and Tall Fescue Mix (mixture of turftype tall fescues).

Lawn Patch also comes in a 5 pound bag which covers about 100 square feet and a 20 pound bag which covers about 300 square feet.

Wildflower Lawn Patch, Herb Patch and Erosion Patch is also available (this is crown vetch with the mulch to help prevent erosion, in addition to perennial ryegrass to help with establishment until the crown vetch germinates).

We also have Hydro-Mites which are 150 and 300 gallon machines available to rent, with the option to buy. If you use these machines the coverage doubles for the grass seed products.
