Results of Height-of-Cut Survey During 1998 Michigan Turfgrass Field Day

On August 19, 1998, during last year's Michigan Turfgrass Field Day, Sports and Commercial Turf Tour participants were asked the following:

"In your opinion is the mowing height of each plot too short, too tall, or OK for a Kentucky bluegrass lawn?"




Fig. 1. Kentucky bluegrass lawn height-of-cut survey responses of 251 attendees at 1998 Michigan Turfgrass Field Day.

The actual mowing heights and the number of replications (3) were not revealed. The written responses, 251, indicated an overall preference for the 3 and 3.5 inch cutting heights (Fig. 1).
