Specific Accomplishments:

- 1. Evaluation of various bermudagrass-bentgrass combinations indicate that
 - a. Relatively slow-growing bermudagrasses such as Sunturf and U-3 are the only ones with which bent can compete.
 - b. It is necessary to now the bermuda very closely and to control thatch.
 - c. Pennoross bent is a better strain for overseeding than is Sesside.
 - d. Further studies of this problem should be of a fundamental nature in order to obtain more facts concerning the nature of growth of the two species.
- Pensacola Bahiagrass and tall feacus are being recommended in Southern California as a good coarse-textured turf for playing fields, large lawn areas, and roughs of golf courses.
- 3. A large collection of <u>Fos</u> annua and <u>Fos</u> bulboss types from all over the world have been planted for evaluation. Many are quite premising as wheter grasses for use with bermudagrass.
