Jim was born in Wisconsin and migrated to the East Coast where he graduated from Penn State University in February of 1978. Before coming to Hidden Valley Country Club as the Assistant Superintendent in February of 1980, Jim was the Superintendent at Carson Valley Country Club in Gardnerville, Nevada. Jim was appointed Superintendent in June 1982.

Hidden Valley Country Club is 7,058 yards the championship blue tees and 6,704 yards from the white tees. The course opened for play in 1958 as the only private course in Northern Nevada. There are only two private courses in the State of Nevada. The greens are Seaside Bent grass, with Blue-Fescue fairways and Alta-Fescue in the rough.
