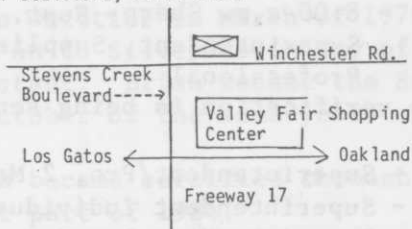

Persons with "CGCS" after their names are "CERTIFIED GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENTS" by the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America.

To earn the title of "Certified Golf Course Superintendent" the individual must demonstrate significant experience in golf course management, and, in addition, prove academic capabilities by passing a comprehensive written examination covering every facet of the profession.

Attaining Certified status is no minor accomplishment. Successful completion of the Certification process indicates the individual's willingness to be judged by the standards of his fellow professionals and assume a position of leadership in the game of golf.

Eligibility standards:

- Require a two-year period as a GCSAA Class A member and currently be employed as a Superintendent
- Have two attestors visit the golf course during the growing season to complete a personal interview and tour of the golf course.
- Must pass a written examination

Certified status expires 5 years from effective date. To renew one must accumulate at least 15 CEU's. These points may be a combination of the following:

- GCSAA Conference Attendance 2 CEU's
- GCSAA Seminar Attendance 2 CEU's for 2 day, 1 CEU for 1 day
- CPR training 1 CEU through American Red Cross or Heart Assoc.
- Attendance at Regional Turfgrass Conferences and Research Field Days
- Attendance at local GCSAA Chapter meetings

A minimum of 3 CEU's of the 15 are required for renewal must be taken from the GCSAA Continuing Education Program. These CEU's may be attained by attending (and passing the exam) GCSAA seminars.
