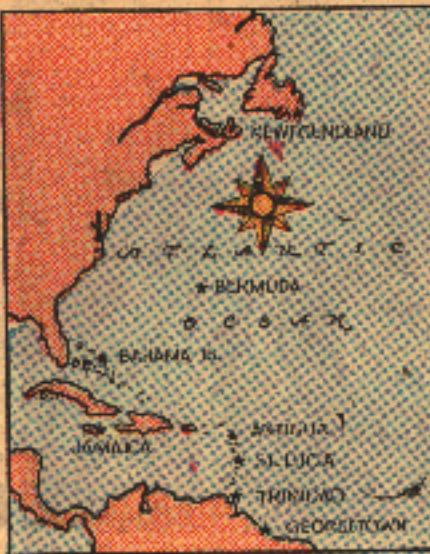


AS WAR CLOUDS THICKENED IN EUROPE, THE PRESIDENT SECURED CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL FOR STRONG ADDITIONS TO OUR NATIONAL DEFENSE.



BY 1940, THE NAZIS HAD OVERRUN EUROPE AND THREATENED THE WHOLE WORLD. PROMPTLY, THE PRESIDENT URGED A LARGE ARMY.

THIS SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM PROVIDES THE MOST DEMOCRATIC MEANS FOR MUSTERING OUR MANPOWER.



TO GUARD AMERICA'S COASTS AND AID THE HARD-PRESSED BRITISH NAVY, IN SEPTEMBER, 1940, THE PRESIDENT EXCHANGED FIFTY OVER-AGE DESTROYERS FOR RIGHTS TO STRATEGIC, BRITISH-OWNED DEFENSE BASES.

A FEW MONTHS LATER, F.D.R. PROPOSED THE LEND-LEASE ACT WHICH SPARKED FACTORIES TO GREATER PRODUCTION OF MUNITIONS.

OUR BEST INTERESTS ARE SERVED BY HELPING ALL WHO RESIST HITLER, INSTEAD OF WAITING FOR THEM TO FALL AND FINDING OURSELVES NEXT IN LINE FOR THE NAZI ATTACK.



WHILE WE STRENGTHENED OUR DEFENSES AND AIDED NATIONS FIGHTING THE NAZIS, F.D.R. AND WINSTON CHURCHILL MET AT SEA IN AUGUST, 1941.

OUR ATLANTIC CHARTER MUST AFFORD ASSURANCE THAT ALL THE MEN IN ALL THE LANDS MAY LIVE OUT THEIR LIVES IN FREEDOM FROM FEAR AND WANT.



ENRAGED BY PEARL HARBOR, AMERICANS OF ALL RANKS, INCLUDING THE PRESIDENT'S FOUR SONS, JOINED THE ARMED SERVICES.



AND ON THE HOME FRONT, UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF THE WAR PRODUCTION BOARD, AMERICAN INDUSTRY WAS ENLISTED IN AN ALL-OUT PRODUCTION DRIVE.



STAGGERED AT FIRST BY THE JAPS' SNEAK ATTACK, AMERICANS FOUGHT BACK GRIMLY, MAKING THE JAPS PAY BITTERLY AT BATAAN AND WAKE ISLAND.



THEN THE TIDE TURNED AT THE BATTLE OF MIDWAY WHEN A JAP INVASION FLEET WAS SMASHED.
