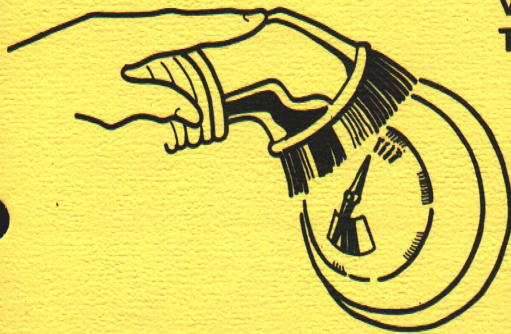

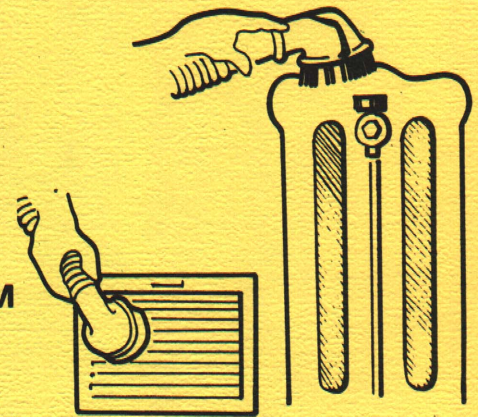
**CHANGE FILTERS YEARLY. CHECK SIZE BEFORE REPLACING.**



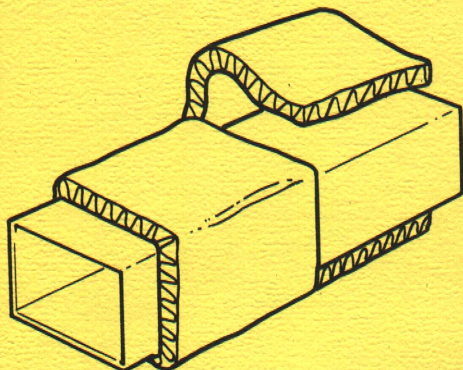
**OIL FAN AND MOTOR BEARINGS WITH 2 OR 3 DROPS AND CHECK FAN BELT.**
