Uneat, declared Dr. David D. Vaughan, professor in Boston University's school of theology, Cambridge, Mass. in an address on "The Ideals of Democracy," given before students of the Sargent College of Physical Education of Boston University. "Those who would frighten us with communism may have, at heart, no serious objection to political absolutism, if such absolutism is likely to work in their interest," Dr. Vaughan stated. "May not the agitation against communism be only a smoke screen to cover the advance of fascism."
