SPORT INTERLUDES- State's Meet

Michigan State will win the twenty-third edition of the State Intercollegiate track and field meet—and win it in a walk. The Spartans will dominate the show in the same manner Notre Dame swept away with the indoor Central Collegiate title last winter. Only State will outscore the Irish, whom as we recall, piled up some 60 points.

State boasts everything for the Collegiates except a good high jumper. In all other events the Spartans will send forth classy entries as far as the 1938 meet is concerned.

The same Spartan performers wouldn't fare so well in many instances in State meets of the past or in present day meets attracting top notch men.

Winner 12 Times

Only three schools—State, Western State and Michigan Normal—have won the team title outright.

Thirty-four of the 56 place winners in last year's meet will compete starting tomorrow. Four are defending champions...

All four point winners in the shot put and discus last spring will again participate. The two-mile pole vault and broad jump each has attracted three place winners of a year ago.

Draws Top Entry

Although considered the toughest race to run, the quarter mile drew the largest entry of any event, 35 competitors.

M. H. (Dad) Butler of the University of Detroit and the meet referee ran his first race in 1887. He has been connected with track as a coach and competitor for 51 years.

With trials in 10 events scheduled, the twenty-third annual State Intercollegiate track and field meet will get underway tomorrow at 2:30 p.m. on the Michigan State track.

The meet has attracted an entry of 145 contestants who will fly the banner of 12 institutions. Michigan State, the defending champion and this year's favorite, heads the team entry list with 42 performers.

Western State Teachers college will have 27 athletes in action, while Michigan Normal, 1937 runner-up by a single point, will count on 21 entrants. Wayne university holds third place with 13 men.
