Statistics Show Spartans Dominated Grid Play

Compiled statistics today revealed that Michigan State's 1939 football record of four games won, four lost, and one tie is not as poor as commonly supposed...

Figures show that the Spartans scored an even 100 points to their opponents' 93, and 81 first downs to 66. Net yardage for nine games gave the State eleven 1,920 to the rivals' 1,601...

Nearly two-thirds of the Spartans' gain was made with a running attack that was good for 1,297 yards compared to the foes' 851...

In the passing and kicking, the latter department in which State was reputed to excel, opponents held an edge. They registered 21 first downs on passes to State's 19, and gained 714 yards to 610. The Green and White attempted 122 aerials and completed 35, while the foes tried 108 and were successful with 41...
